The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas the above bounden

Ben Swanson & others

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State
of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public ditch

Commencing at a point where
along the following described route: County Ditch No. 44 of Anoka
County intersects the North and south Quarter Section line of Section twenty-
seven (27) in Township thirty-two (32) and North of range numbered Twenty-
three (23), said point being also the intersection of Coon Creek, so called,
with the said quarter section line, thence following generally the course
of Coon Creek, West through the Town of Ham Lake in said county, and contin-
uing West, following generally the course of said Creek through the said
town of Ham Lake in said Anoka County, widening, deepening and cutting the
bends of the same, to the point where public ditch numbered 2 joins the said
Coon Creek, so called, in the North Half (N 1/2) of the Southeast Quarter
(SE 1/4) of Section thirty (30) township thirty two (32) North of Range
twenty-three (23) in said Anoka County, and there terminating in the said
Coon Creek as its outlet; with such branches, extensions and laterals as
may be proper and necessary to effect the purpose of the drainage project
herein petitioned for and to include branches extending in the same general
direction as other creeks flowing into the said Coon Creek at any point along
the route of the proposed ditch as above set forth, and as may be deemed
necessary and proper by the engineer appointed in these proceedings, and as
provided by law

Now, if the said Ben Swanson

shall pay all expenses, in case the Board of County Commissioners of said County and the Court in
case of appeal according to law, shall fail to establish said proposed ditch
then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
