Auditor's Notice of Pendency of Petition.

Whereas, the owners of certain lands in the Town of Grow, of said Anoka County, upon the petition of Wm. F. Hopper, E. Davis, J. K. Broadbent, Pedar Anderson and E. L. Mantor, bearing date the 29th day of March, 1890, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting in special session at the court house in Anoka, on the 23rd day of August, 1890, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: At a point at or near the northeast corner of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter, of section 10, township 32, range 24, thence running in a general westerly and southerly direction for one mile, more or less, through section 15 to section 16, thence in a general westerly and northerly direction through sections 16, 17, 8 & 7, following, as near as practicable, the natural water courses through said sections.
