**Whereas,** The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Suoka  
 State of Minnesota, did establish and order to be constructed a certain Ditch  
 designated as No. 6 which number has been given to said Ditch  
 by the County Auditor

by their order, bearing date the 23<sup>d</sup> day of August 1890,  
 and according to the report of the viewers thereof, all of which  
 are on file in the office of the said County Auditor;

**And Whereas,** At a public sale of the jobs of digging and constructing the entire work in  
 linear sections of 100 feet each, each of which sections is marked and known and numbered by the
