PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the ~~public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a~~ Construction of said Ditch will be ~~along the following described route in the Town of Conduvieve to the public health~~ convenience and welfare, and in said County of the same will be of public ~~to wit: Commencing at~~ benefit and utility, and we the undersigned hereby petition and request the said Board of County Commissioners ~~to cause to be constructed a Ditch along the following described~~ route in the Town of Grow in said County of Anoka - to wit: Commencing ~~at a point at or near the North East corner of the South West~~ Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Ten (10) Township ~~(32) Thirty-two Range (24) Twenty-four, thence running in a~~ general westerly and southerly direction for one mile more ~~or less through Section (15) Fifteen to Section (16) Sixteen in said~~ Township and Range, thence in a general westerly and northerly ~~and terminating at direction through Sections (16-17, 8 & 7) Sixteen, Seventeen,~~ Eight and Seven, following as near as practicable the ~~natural water courses through said sections. Said Ditch to terminate~~ at its outlet at Run River at or near the North East corner of Section ~~Seven (7), Township Thirty-two (32), Range Twenty-four as its outlet.~~ All of the said Sections being in the Township and Range aforesaid.
