SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

Notice is Hereby Given, That, on the 16th day of October
1890, at 11 o'clock A. M., at the County Auditor's Office
in the City of Anoka

I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 6 of Anoka
County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County,
State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date August 23^d 1890, viz.:

In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by
the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from
thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source, the place of commencement
of said ditch at its source is in a marsh near the
center of the South East Quarter of Section Ten (10)
Township Thirty-two (32) Range Twenty-four (24),
thence running in a general westerly and southerly
direction for one mile or less through Section Fifteen
(15) to Section Sixteen (16) in said Township and
Range, thence in a general westerly and northerly
direction through Sections 16, 9, 17, 8 & 7, said ditch
to terminate at Run River near the center of the
North East Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section
Seven (7) Town 32, Range 24, as its outlet

to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and
in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more
than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated
in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two
freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all
damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the
contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.
