Whereas, the owners of certain lands in the town of Blaine of said Anoka county, upon the petition of Jas. T. Elwell and C. P. Lovell bearing date the 28th day of May, 1890, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting in special session at the court house, in Anoka, on the 22d day of November, 1890, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: Commencing in a marsh 711 feet north and 420 feet east of the section corner common to sections 26, 27, 34, and 35, town 31, range 23, thence running in a southerly and westerly direction over and across sections (27) twenty-seven and (34) thirty-four in said township and range.

The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed ditch passes are as follows: George Scouten, Chas. P. Lovell, Hoyt S. Delvin, J. S. Pillsbury and Fred. B. Snyder.

The place of termination of said ditch at its outlet is as follows: At a point on the south end 1034 feet east of the south line of section 34, town 31, range 23.

The names of the owners of the lands therein are George Scouten, Hoyt S. Delvin, James T. Elwell & Kitchener, dated the 20th of November, 1890.
