Auditor's Notice of Pendency of Petition.

E. 1/4 of Sec. 6, town 32, range 23, through said Sec. 6, thence through Section 1, town 32, range 24, Sec. 12, 2, 11, 3, in said last town and range and terminating in Sec. 34, town 23, range 24 in Clark's brook, (so called); also branch "A" commencing in the S. W. 1/4 of S. E. 1/4, Sec. 6, town 32, range 23, running through said Sec. 6, also through Sec. 1 and 2, in town 32, range 24, terminating in main ditch in said Sec. 2, also branch "B" commencing in the N. E. 1/4 of S. W. 1/4 of Sec. 12, town 32, range 24, through said Sec. 12 and terminating in main ditch near north quarter part of said Sec. 12, also branch "C" commencing in N. E. 1/4 of S.
