Notice is hereby given, that, on the 2nd day of May, 1891, at 10 o'clock A. M., at the County Auditor's Office, in the City of Anoka, I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 7 of Anoka County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date February 21st, 1891, viz: In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source. The place of commencement of said Ditch is as follows: Commencing at or near a point eighty rods south of the west quarter post of Section (26) twenty-six, Town (31) thirty-one, Range (23) twenty-three. Thence running in a southerly and westerly direction over and across Sections (27) twenty-seven and (34) thirty-four in said Township and Range, and terminating at a point on the county line at or near the south quarter post of said Section (34) thirty-four, Township (31) thirty-one, Range (23) twenty-three, to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.
