PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch Drain or Water course hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a Construction of said Ditch Drain along the following described route in the Town of Water course will be conducive to the public health convenience in said County of and welfare and the same to wit: Commencing at will be of public benefit, ^{and} utility, and we the undersigned hereby petition and request the said Board of County Commissioners to cause to be constructed a Ditch Drain or Water course along the following described route in the town of Blaine in said County of Anoka to wit: — Commencing at or near a point eighty rods south of the West Quarter post of Section (26) Twenty six Town (31) Thirty one Range (23) Twenty three — thence running in a southerly and westerly direction over and across Sections (27) Twenty seven and (34) Thirty four in said Township and Range and terminating at a point on the county line at or near the south quarter post of said section (34) Thirty four Township (31) Thirty one Range (23) Twenty three as its outlet.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such Ditch Drain or Water course and cause the same to be constructed as provided by

Chapter 97 General Laws of Minnesota, 1887.
