have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State
of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public Ditch

along the following described route: in the Town of Blaine in said
County of Anoka
Commencing at a Marsh Lake in the South East quarter
of the North East quarter of Section 28. Town 31 Range
23. thence in a North easterly direction through sections 22, 23,
15 and 14 said Town and Range to the east line of said Section
14. and there terminating also a branch to the same commencing
in a Marsh Lake on the south line of the north east quarter of Section
27. said Town & Range at a point about 80 rods west of the east quarter
post of said Section 27. thence North easterly through sections 27, 26, 22, 23 so
far as necessary to connect with main ditch above described as its outlet

Now, if the said James T. Edwell and L. P. Lovell

shall pay all expenses, in case the Board of County Commissioners of said County shall fail to
establish said proposed Ditch then, the above obligation
