along the following described route: in the Town of Columbus

Ham Lake and Linwood commencing on the east line of section
30 Town 33 Range 22 about 40 rods south of the East quarter post (1/4) of said section
thence easterly in as direct a line as possible through sections 29, 28 and 27 in
said Town and Range to South Branch creek (so called) thence down said
creek to the point where it crosses the county line and there terminating.

Also a Branch commencing at or near the North quarter post
of Section 1, Town 32 Range 23 and thence easterly and
northerly through Section 6, Town 32 Range 22 and Sections
