have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State
 of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public Road

along the following described route: Said road to Commence
on the section line between sections Eleven 11 and
and 12 in the Township of Bethel, Anoka County, Minnesota
where the road is now worked and traveled, being a
little south of the center of the said sections;
Said road to run in a direct line south between
Sections 11-12-13 and 14-23 and 24-25 and 26 to
the point where it would seem to be shortest and most
practical point to cross Coon Lake Narrows thence south to
a point between sections 1 and 2 between section line between
