## Notice

Notice is hereby given that a petition signed by Jas. J. Clewell and others will be presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County Minnesota at their next regular session to be held at the Court house in Anoka March 7<sup>th</sup> 1890 praying for the establishment of a public Ditch in the Town of Ham Lake in said County said petition being in words and figures as follows to wit:

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for the expense of the cost of construction of the Ditch hereinafter described would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment of a Ditch along the following route in the Town of Ham Lake in said County of Anoka commencing at or near <sup>the</sup> northern corner of South East quarter (1/4) of the South East quarter (1/4) of Section 2 Town 32 Range 23 thence in a generally southerly and westerly direction through Sections 11-14-22-23 and 27 said Town and Range, to Coon Creek (so called) as its outlet, and there terminate, and your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such Ditch and cause the same to be constructed as provided by Chapter Ninety seven (97) General Laws of Minnesota 1887 - Dated January 31<sup>st</sup> 1890
