Notice is hereby given that a petition signed by Jas. J. Elwell and others will be presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka Co Minnesota, at their next regular session to be held at the Court house in Anoka on March 7th 1890 praying for the establishment of a public Ditch in the Towns of Blair and Centreville in said County. Said petition being in words and figures as follows to wit:

WESTERN MILLS.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota.

The undersigned land owner whose land will be liable to be affected by or assessed for the expense of the construction of the ditch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health convenience and welfare requires the establishment and construction of a ditch with two branches along the following route in the Towns of Blair & Centreville in said County of Anoka - To wit: Commencing at a point on the section line between Sections 13 and 14 Town 31 Range 23 about 120 rods north of the quarter (1/4) post & thence easterly

10 at a point on the section line between Sections
11 13 and 14. Town 31 Range 23 about 120 rods
12 north of the quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) post & thence easterly
13 through Sections 13 and 12 said Town
14 and Range and Section 7 Town 31 and
15 Range 22 to connect with a public ditch
16 known as "Penne Hitch" in said Section 7
17 thence down said ditch about 200 rods for an
18 outlet and there terminate for main line
19 Also a branch to commence at a point on
20 the Section line between Sections 1 and 12
21 Town 31 Range 23 about 80 rods east of the
22 quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) post and thence in a southerly
23 direction to main ditch in said Section 7
24 for an outlet and there terminate. Also a
25 branch commencing at or near the West quart
26 er ($\frac{1}{4}$) post of Section 6 Town 31 Range 22 and
27 thence in a southerly direction to said main
28 ditch in Section 7 said Town & Range for an
29 outlet & there terminate and your petitioners
30 pray that you will proceed to establish such
31 ditch and cause the same to be constructed as pro
32 vided for by chapter ninety seven (97) General Laws of
Minnesota 1887 - Dated January 31st, 1890.
