Range 22 in the Town of Linwood at forks of roads in N. 8 1/4 Sec 9, at the Post Office in Linwood and at G. A. R. Hall in Sec 18. all in Town 33 Range 22 in the Town of Ham Lake at the School House in School District No. 24 in Sec. 15. and a public Road in Section 21. and at School House in School District No. 54 in Sec. 33 all in Town 32. Range 23

Notice is hereby given that a petition signed by Jas. J. Ellwell and others will be presented to the board of County Commissioners of Anoka County Minnesota at their next regular session to be held at the Court house in Anoka on March 7th 1890 praying for the establishment of a Public Ditch in the Towns of Columbus, Linwood and Ham Lake in said County said petition being in words and figures as follows, to wit

To the Board of County Commissioners
County of Anoka State of Minnesota.

The undersigned land owners whose lands will be liable to be affected by or assessed for the expense of the construction of the ditch hereby petitioned for would respectfully represent that the public health convenience and welfare requires the establishment & construction of a ditch along the following described route in the Towns of Columbus Ham Lake and Linwood in said County of Anoka To Wit: Commencing on the east line of Section 30 Town 33 Range 22 about 40 rods south of the east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) part of said Section thence easterly in as direct a line as possible through Sections 29-28 and 27 in said Town and Range to South Branch Creek (so called) thence down said Creek to the point where it crosses the county line & there terminating. Also a branch commencing at or near the north quarter

Ham Lake and Linwood in said County of
Anoka To Wit: Commencing on the east
line of Section 30 Town 33 Range 22 about
40 rods south of the east quarter (1/4) post
of said Section thence easterly in as direct
a line as possible through Sections 29-28
and 27 in said Town and Range to South
Branch Creek (so called) thence down said
Creek to the point where it crosses the county
line & there terminating. Also a branch
commencing at or near the north quarter
(1/4) post of Section 1 Town 32 Range 23
and thence easterly and northerly through
Section 6 Town 32 Range 22 and Sections
31 and 32 Town 33 Range 22 to intersect
main line in Section 29 in said Town
and Range and there terminating and your
petitioners pray that you will proceed to
establish such ditch & cause ^{the} same to be con-
structed as provided by chapter 97 General
Laws of Minnesota 1887
