Commeceas, A petition bearing date the 28<sup>th</sup> day of May 1890, signed by Edw. W. C. Swell and Le. P. Howell

praying for the establishment of a certain Ditch Drainage Water ~~to~~ in said County, the route of which is more fully described in said petition, and a proper bond accompanying the same, have been filed with the County Auditor of said County, as by law required;

And Commeceas, It appears, by satisfactory proof to the Board of County Commissioners of Shuabeka County, that at least thirty (30) days' notice of the pendency of said petition, and the time and place at which the same would be heard, has been given as required by law;

And Commeceas, Said Board has determined that the construction of such ditch as proposed in said petition will be of public benefit or utility, or conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare;

Now, therefore, We, the Board of County Commissioners of said County, at a Special session held this day, do hereby accept said petition, do hereby appoint John Hueston John Gardner and L. M. Hatak

three resident freeholders of said County, and not interested in the construction of said proposed work, and not of kin to any parties interested therein, as viewers, and do specify the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 1890, at the County Auditor's Office in the City of Shuabeka Shuabeka Shuabeka as the time and place for said viewers to meet, preparatory to commencing their duties as such viewers, as prescribed by law, and after completing their duties as such viewers to make and file their report with the County Auditor of said County, on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1890
