The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas the above bounden JAMES T. EWELL and C. P. LOVELL

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of ANOKA County, State

of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public Ditch, Drain or Water

Course along the following described route: Commencing at a point on or

near a point about thirty rods east of the center of Section Thirty Three [33]

Town Thirty One [31] Range Twenty Three [23] Anoka County; Thence running

Northerly and westerly direction over and across Sections 33-28-21-20-18-17-18-

in said Town and Range and into "Sand Creek"-so called- Thence down said Creek

through Sections 12 in TOWN 31 Range 24 to the west line of said Section 12 and

terminating at the point where said Sand Creek crosses the west line of said

Section Twelve [12], as its outlet.
