Whereas, the owners of certain lands in the town of Blaine and Anoka, of said Anoka county, upon the petition of Jas. T. Elwell and C. P. Lovell, bearing date the 28th day of May, 1890, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting in special session, at the court house, in Anoka, on the 22d day of November, 1890, at 10 o'clock a. m. The place of commencement of said ditch at its source, is as follows: Commencing at a point 1055 feet east of the center of section thirty-three (33), town 31, range 28, Anoka county, thence running northerly and westerly through sections 38, 29, 21, 16, 17, 13 and 14, in said town and range, and into Sand Creek, so called, thence down said Creek through sections 13 and 12, in town 31, range 24, to the west line of said section 12. Said ditch to be No. 8.
