Whereas a petition has been presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Jackson State of Minnesota, praying for the location of a Public ditch therein known as Ditch No. 8 - and said ditch passes over and through certain lands belonging to the undersigned Alvan Johnson and George D. Parker in a private ditch already constructed which ditch is now of sufficient capacity to carry off all the water from the lands of the Petitioners and all other lands situated above our lands on the line of said ditch to be benefited by the construction of the same: Now in case the said Board of County Commissioners shall and do yield and allow said Public ditch, we and each of us do hereby undertake promise and agree for and during the term and time of the years from and after date hereof to keep said ditch over and through our said lands, to-wit: the North West quarter of Section 28. in Township 31. of Range 23, in said County, cleared out, opened and of sufficient capacity to carry off all water from the lands situated above our said lands on the line of said proposed Public ditch, so that the lands of said Petitioners and all other lands on the line of said ditch above our said lands shall have a free and unobstructed outlet for water therefrom, and this shall be a covenant running with said land and bind ourselves our heirs, executors administrators and assigns -
