Auditor's Notice of Pendency of Petition.

STATE OF MINNESOTA, } ss.
 County of Anoka.

Whereas, the owners of certain lands in the town of Blaine of said Anoka county, upon the petition of Jas. T. Elwell and C. P. Lovell bearing date the 23th day of May, 1890, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch and its branch along the route proposed therein.

Now, therefore, Notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting in special session at the court house, in Anoka, on the 22d day of November, 1890, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch with its branch at its source is as follows: Main ditch commencing at a marsh lake in the center of the $\frac{se}{4}$ of $\frac{ne}{4}$ of section 23, township 31, range 23, thence running in a north and easterly direction over and across sections 28, 27, 22, 23, and 14 in said township and range. The branch ditch commencing in a marsh at the NW corner of the $\frac{ne}{4}$ of the $\frac{se}{4}$ of section 27, town 31, range 23, thence running north and easterly over and across sections 27, 22 and 23, said town and range.

The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed ditch and its branch passes are as follows: J. T. Elwell, John Greek, George Wall and C. P. Lovell.

The place of termination of said ditch and its branch at its outlet is as follows: Main ditch terminating at a point on the east line of said section 14, 1330 feet north of section corner, common to sections 13, 14, 23 and 24, town 31, range 23, and the termination of the branch ditch is in the $\frac{nw}{4}$ of the $\frac{ne}{4}$ of section 23, town 31, range 23, in the main ditch at stake No. 134 of said main ditch. Said ditch to be No. 9.

The names of the owners of the lands that will be affected thereby are E. M. Wilson, Jas T. Elwell, Henry Otte, C. P. Lovell, United States, (entered by John Greek), Johnson & Parker, George Wall and Gilbert Jevna.
