SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

Notice is Hereby Given, That, on the 12th day of March
1891, at 10 o'clock A. M., at the County Auditor's Office
in the City of Anoka

I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 9 of Anoka
County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County,
State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date January 7th 1891, viz.:

In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by
the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from
thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source. The place of commencement
of said Ditch and Branch at its source is as follows: commencing
at a Marsh Lake on the S. 1/4 of the N. 1/4 of Section 28, Township 31,
Range 23. Thence running in a north and easterly direction over and
across Sections 28, 27, 22, 23, 15 and 14 in said Township and Range
and terminating at a point at or near the East line of said Section
14, at or near the East quarter part of said Section 14, as its outlet,
Also a Branch to said Ditch commencing at or near a point
80 rods west of the East quarter part of Section 27, Township 31, Range 23,
thence running in a north and easterly direction over and
across Sections 27, 26, 22 & 23 said Township and Range
so far as may be necessary and practicable to connect
with Main Ditch as its outlet.

to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and
in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more
than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated
in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two
freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all
damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the
contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.
