PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch Drain or water course with its branch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a construction of said Ditch Drain along the following described route in the Town of Water course with its branch will be conducive to the public in said County of health convenience and to-wit: Commencing at welfare and that the same will be of public benefit and as title and we the undersigned hereby petition and request the said Board of County Commissioners to cause to be constructed a Ditch Drain or Water course with its branch along the following described route in the town of Blaine in said Anoka County to-wit: Commencing at a marsh lake on the (S 1/4 NW 1/4) South East Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section (28) Twenty eight Township (31) Thirty one Range (23) Twenty three These run in a north and easterly direction over and across sections (28) Twenty eight, 27 Twenty seven, (22) Twenty two, 23 Twenty three (15) fifteen and (14) fourteen in said Township and Range and terminating at a point at or near the east line of said section (14) fourteen at or near the east quarter post of said section (14) fourteen

as its outlet. Also a branch to said Ditch Drain or water course described as follows to-wit: Commencing at or near a point eighty (80) rods west of the east quarter post of section (27) Twenty seven Township (31) Thirty one Range (23) Twenty three These running in a north and easterly direction over and across sections (27) Twenty seven (26) Twenty six (23) Twenty two, (23) Twenty three of said Township and Range so far as may be necessary and practicable to connect with main ditch drain or water course above described as its outlet.
