Highway Web Application Tools

Basic ID tools:

Clicking on any of the projects, road closures or detours on the map will produce a popup window with project information and a link to additional information.

Search/Locate tools:

Address, PIN, Intersection Q. Use this tool to search for an address, property ID or a street

intersection.

-- Address search: Enter an address. As you are typing the address, suggested addresses will populate the dropdown. If you see the address in the dropdown, click on it and the map will zoom to that address.

Tips:

-Do not include city name or any punctuation.


-If you are having trouble locating an address, try entering just the house number, or just the street name, or even just a portion of the street name.

--Property ID search: Enter a property ID in this format: 06-31-24-33-0108.

--Intersection search: Enter in this format: [street name]&[street name] For example, 3rd&Jackson. Select the intersection you are interested in from the dropdown.

Project search: Enter any portion of the road name and select from the drop down. For example, "County Road" or "CSAH" or the county road number.

Navigation tools:



****If you have a mouse wheel, that also works for zooming in and out

Pictometry Tool: Used to view oblique aerial photos. Click on the Pictometry icon to open the tool. Click on the map where you would like to view oblique aerial photos. Use the compass in the upper left corner of the Pictometry window to rotate the view of the photos.



Basemaps: Choose between various aerial photos by year or revert to the basic basemap.



Layers: Turn layers on/off.



Measurement Tool: Measure length, area and find latitude, longitude a point.

Miscellaneous tools (Upper right – you may need to close the legend):

Bookmark: You can use this tool to add a bookmark to the map so that you can quickly return to an area of interest on the map. To add a bookmark, click on the icon with the plus sign on it in the Bookmark pop-up window. Name the bookmark and click add. To retrieve a bookmark, click on the icon on the left in the bookmark popup window and select the bookmark you want.
