SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The traffic control at the intersection of CSAH 12 (109th Ave.) and Jefferson St. shall be provided by Blaine Police. An Anoka County Highway Department Signal Division Technician will place the signal in 4-way flash mode. Traffic will then be directed through the intersection by a minimum of one Blaine Police Officer until the final parade unit has passed. Eastbound and westbound traffic on CSAH 12 (109th Ave.) may be held for maximum lengths of 1 1/2 to 2 minutes which is consistent with a normal signal cycle.

Immediately following the parade the signal shall be placed back into normal operation by an Anoka County Highway Dept. Signal Division Technician. Arrangement of the ACHD Signal Technician shall be coordinated at least 5 business days in advance with Mark Lekson, Signal Division at 612-801-8969. All costs associated with the ACHD Signal Technician will be the City of Blaine's responsibility.

Anoka County Highway Dept. will be working on the final stages of the reconstruction of CSAH 51 (University Ave.) between CSAH 12 (109th Ave.) and 121st Ave. Please be aware, subject to the timing of the reconstruction project, this portion of CSAH 12 (109th Ave.) could potentially see heavier traffic volumes than normal.

As in past years, the Anoka County Highway Department strongly urges the City of Blaine to find another route for future events. CSAH 12 is a vital east - west link in the County Highway System. By finding a new route that does not involve the County Highway System the safety and operational impacts, as well as the delays to through traffic that are caused by this event can be eliminated.
