



JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT
 FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL LED RETROFITTING
 AND PEDESTRIAN PUSH BUTTON REPLACEMENTS
 IN THE CITY OF COON RAPIDS
 (S.P. 114-030-10, City Project 09-18)

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2009 by and between the County of Anoka, a political subdivision of the State of Minnesota, 21160 Third Avenue, Anoka, Minnesota 55303, hereinafter referred to as "County", and the City of Coon Rapids, 11155 Robinson Drive, Coon Rapids, MN 55433, hereinafter referred to as "City".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties to this Agreement desire to jointly cause the retrofitting of traffic signal LED's and the replacement of pedestrian push buttons at existing traffic signals; and,

WHEREAS, the parties to this Agreement agree that it is in their best interest that the costs of said projects be the city's responsibility; and,

WHEREAS, the City has prepared plans and specifications for the project which are on file in the office of the Anoka County Highway Department; and,

WHEREAS, said work will be carried out in accordance with the provisions of Minn. Stat. § 471.59.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually stipulated and agreed:

I. PURPOSE:

The County and the City have joined together for the purpose of retrofitting of traffic signal LED's and the replacement of pedestrian push buttons, as described in the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Anoka County Highway Department and incorporated herein by reference. The locations are as follows:

II. METHOD:

A. The City shall provide all Engineering services and shall cause the construction of said project No. S.P. 114-030-10 (City Project 09-18) in conformance with said plans and specifications. The City shall do the calling for all bids and acceptance of all bid proposals.

B. The County shall provide traffic signal inspection services to the city on a reimbursable basis as needed for this project.

III. COSTS

The City shall be responsible for all construction costs associated with the project and shall reimburse the county for 100% of the County's traffic signal inspection costs related to this project as per standard quarterly billing.

IV. SIGNALIZATION POWER

The City, shall, at their sole expense, continue to cause the installation of an adequate electrical power source to the locations previously mentioned, including any necessary extensions of power lines as per existing Joint Powers Agreements for each intersection. The City shall continue to be the lead agency in this matter. Upon completion of said traffic control signal revisions, the ongoing cost of electrical power to the signals shall be the sole cost and expense of the City as per existing Joint Powers Agreements for each intersection.

V. MAINTENANCE

The County Highway Department shall maintain the traffic signal controller, traffic signal lamps, loop detectors, associated wiring with the traffic control systems and traffic signal painting as per existing Joint Powers Agreements for each intersection.

VI. TERM:

This Agreement shall continue until terminated as provided hereinafter.

VII. DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS:

All funds disbursed by the County or the City pursuant to this Agreement shall be disbursed by each entity pursuant to the method provided by law.

VIII. CONTRACTS AND PURCHASES:

All contracts let and purchases made pursuant to this Agreement shall be made by the County and City in conformance to state laws.

IX. STRICT ACCOUNTABILITY:

A strict accounting shall be made of all funds and report of all receipts and disbursements shall be made upon request by either party.

X. TERMINATION:

This Agreement may be terminated by either party at any time, with or without cause, upon not less than thirty (30) days written notice delivered by mail or in person to the other party. If notice is delivered by mail, it shall be deemed to be received two (2) days after mailing. Such termination shall not be effective with respect to any solicitation of bids or any purchases of services or goods, which occurred prior to such notice of termination.

XI. AFFIRMATIVE ACTION:

In accordance with the County of Anoka's Affirmative Action Policy and the Anoka County Commissioners' policies against discrimination, no person shall illegally be excluded from full-time employment rights in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in the program which is the subject of this Agreement on the basis of race, creed, color, sex, marital status, public assistance status, age, disability or national origin.

XII. NOTICE:

For purpose of delivery of any notices hereunder, the notice shall be effective if delivered to the County Administrator of Anoka County, 2100 Third Avenue, Anoka, Minnesota 55303, on behalf of the County, and the City Manager of the City of Coon Rapids, 11155 Robinson Drive, Coon Rapids, MN 55433, on behalf of the City.

XIII. INDEMNIFICATION:

The City and the County of Anoka mutually agree to indemnify and hold harmless each other from any claims, losses, costs, expenses or damages resulting from the acts or omissions of the respective officers, agents or employees relating to activity conducted by either party under this Agreement.

XIV. ENTIRE AGREEMENT/REQUIREMENT OF A WRITING:

It is understood and agreed that the entire agreement of the parties is contained herein and that this Agreement supersedes all oral agreements and all negotiations between the parties relating to the subject matter thereof, as well as any previous agreement presently in effect between the parties relating to the subject matter thereof. Any alterations, variations or modifications of the provisions of this Agreement shall be valid only when they have been reduced to writing and duly signed by the parties herein.


