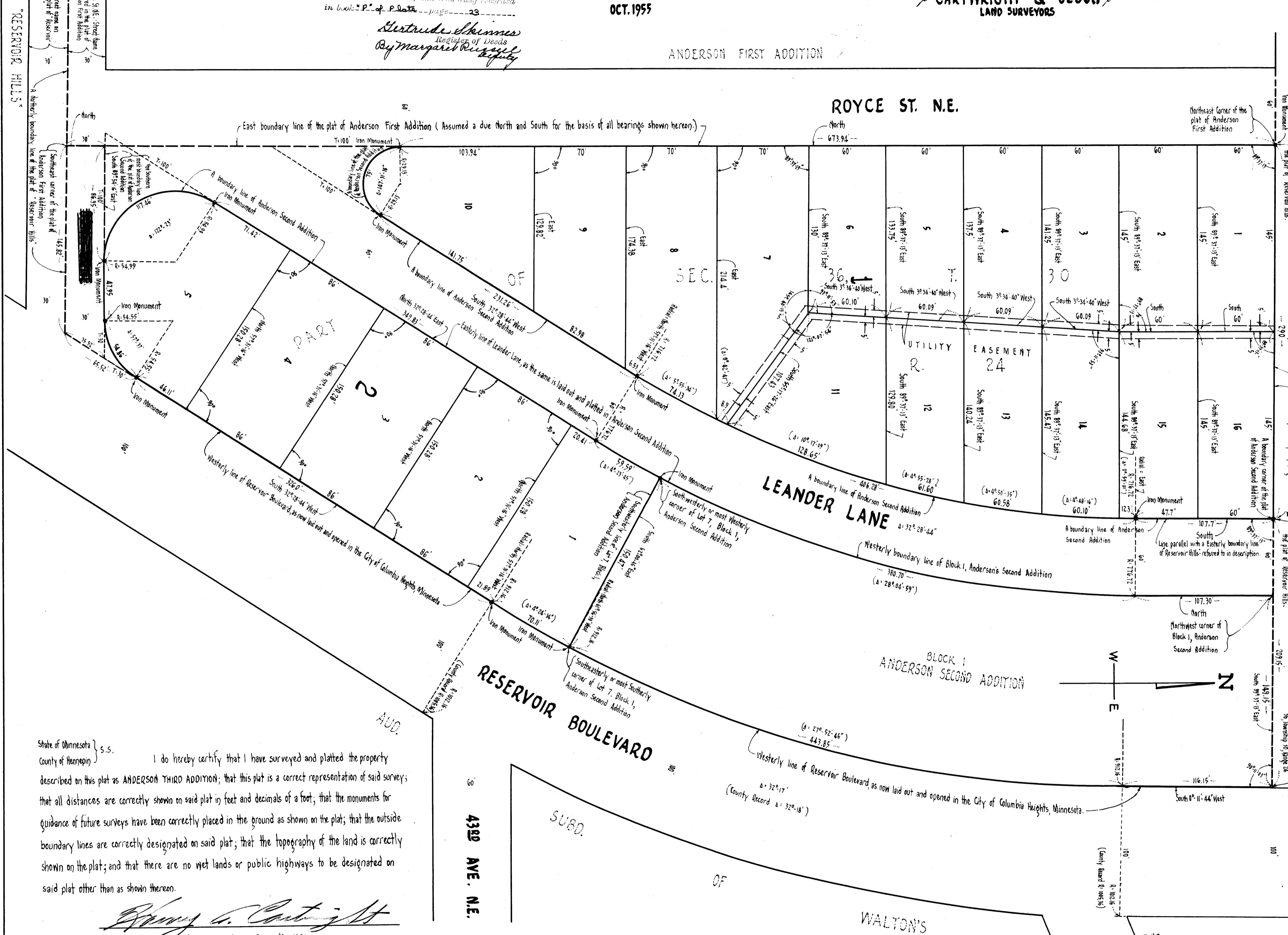

Know all men by these presents that we Paul L. Anderson and Frieda I. Anderson, his wife, as joint tenants, owners and proprietors of the following described properties situate in the State of Minnesota and County of Anoka to-wit: That part of Section 36, Township 30, Range 24, described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of Lot 7, Block 1, Anderson Second Addition, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Anoka County, Minnesota, thence Northwesterly along the Southwesterly or most Southwesterly line of the aforesaid Lot 7, Block 1, Anderson Second Addition to the Southwesterly or most Westerly corner of the aforesaid Lot 7, Block 1, Anderson Second Addition, said corner is located on the Easterly line of Leander Lane, as the same is laid out and platted in the aforesaid Anderson Second Addition; thence Southwesterly along the Southwesterly line of the aforesaid Leander Lane, said course being on a circular curve, convex to the Southeast, having a radius of 776.72 feet, a distance of 59.59 feet to the end of curve, as the same is laid out and platted in the aforesaid Anderson Second Addition; thence continuing Southwesterly along the Southwesterly line of the aforesaid Leander Lane, said course being a line tangent to the last described curve in this description a distance of 349.83 feet to a point of curve on said Southwesterly line of the aforesaid Leander Lane, as the same is laid out and platted in the aforesaid Anderson Second Addition, thence in a general Southerly direction along the general Easterly line of the aforesaid Leander Lane on a tangential curve to the left, having a radius of 54.99 feet a distance of 117.46 feet to a boundary corner of the aforesaid Anderson Second Addition, said boundary corner is 30 feet North of, measured at right angles, to a Northerly boundary line of "Reservoir Hills", according to the thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Anoka County, Minnesota; thence West along the Southern most boundary line of the aforesaid Anderson Second Addition a distance of 86.95 feet to a boundary corner of the aforesaid Anderson Second Addition, which last described boundary corner is located on the East boundary line of Anderson First Addition, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Anoka County, Minnesota; thence South along the East line of the aforesaid Anderson First Addition to the Southeast corner of the aforesaid Anderson First Addition, said last described boundary corner being on a Northerly boundary line of the aforesaid Anderson First Addition, thence East along said Northerly boundary line of the aforesaid Anderson First Addition to the Westerly line of Reservoir Boulevard, as the same is now laid out and opened in the City of Columbia Heights, Minnesota; thence Northwesterly along said Westerly line of the aforesaid Reservoir Boulevard to the point of commencement; according to the United States Government Survey thereof, and also, that part of Section 36, Township 30, Range 24, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the Westerly line of Reservoir Boulevard, as the same is laid out and opened in the City of Columbia Heights, Minnesota, which point is 698 feet South of the North line of said Section 36, thence West on a line parallel with the North line of said Section 36 to a point thereon distant 650 feet Easterly of, measured at right angles to the Easterly boundary line of the plat of "Reservoir Hills", according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Anoka County, Minnesota, which point is a boundary corner of the plat of Anderson Second Addition, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Anoka County, Minnesota, said boundary corner being the actual point of beginning of the tract of land to be hereinafter described, thence Southerly on a line parallel with the Easterly boundary line of said "Reservoir Hills", as described heretofore in this description, 107.7 feet, said last described course being a boundary line of the aforesaid Anderson Second Addition; thence continuing Southwesterly on a tangential curve to the right having a radius of 716.72 feet a distance of 406.28 feet, said last described course being a boundary line of the aforesaid Anderson Second Addition; thence continuing Southwesterly on a line tangent to the last described curve a distance of 231.26 feet, said last described course being a boundary line of the aforesaid Anderson Second Addition; thence continuing in a general Westerly and Northerly direction on a tangential curve to the right, having a radius of 29.13 feet a distance of 75 feet to a point on a line parallel with and 360 feet Easterly of, measured at right angles to the Easterly boundary line of said "Reservoir Hills", as described heretofore in this description, said last described curve being also tangent to the line last described being parallel with the Easterly boundary line of "Reservoir Hills" as described heretofore in this description, said last described course being a boundary line of the aforesaid Anderson Second Addition; thence Northerly along said last described parallel line a distance of 673.94 feet to the intersection of a line drawn parallel with the North line of said Section 36 from the actual point of beginning, said last described course being along the Easterly boundary line of Anderson First Addition, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Anoka County, Minnesota; thence East on a line parallel with the North line of said Section 36 a distance of 290 feet to the actual point of beginning, according to the United States Government Survey thereof; have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as ANDERSON THIRD ADDITION; and do hereby donate and dedicate to the public for the public use, forever, the land as shown on the annexed plat, and also, subject, however, to the easement for utility purposes as shown on the annexed plat.
