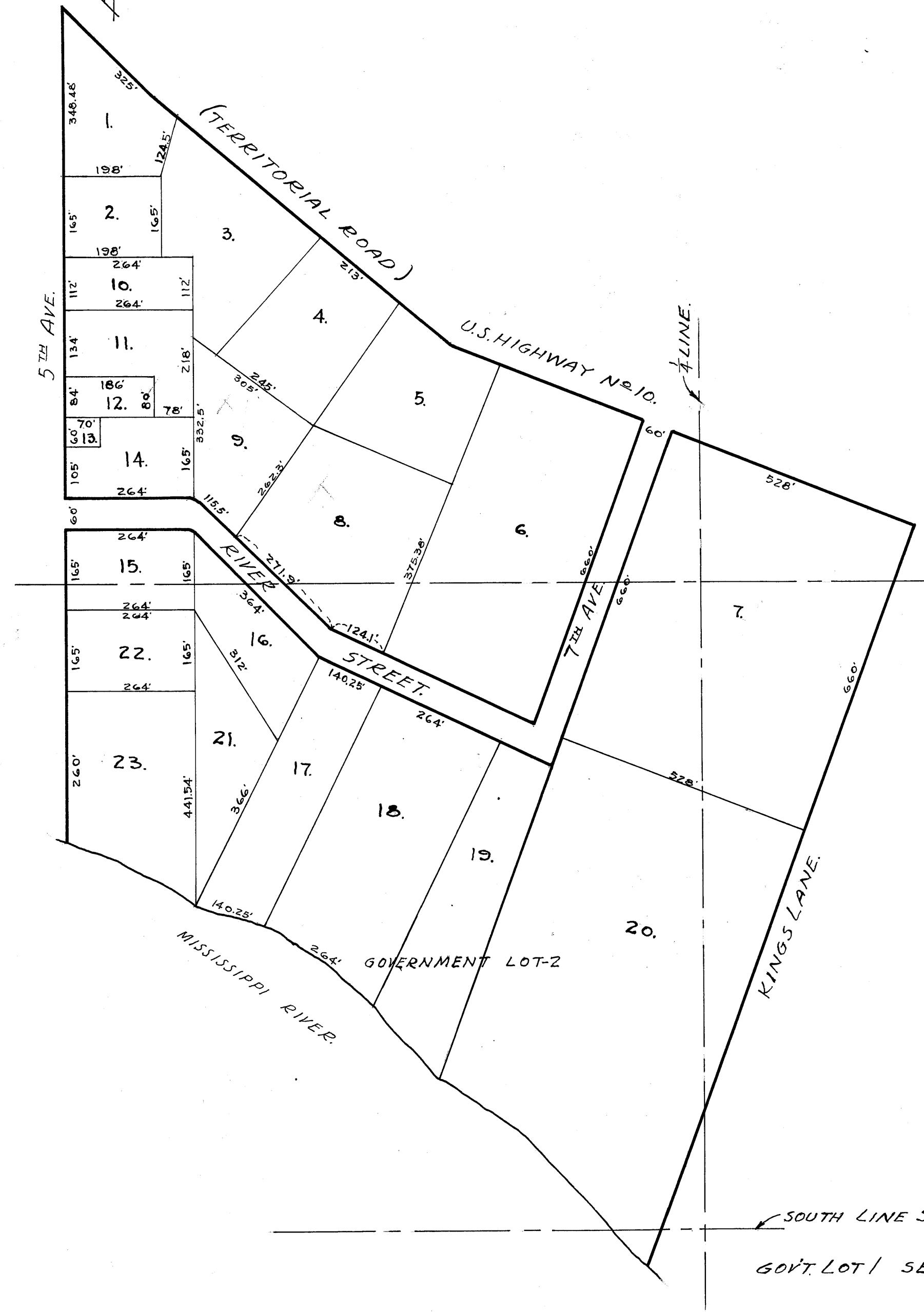
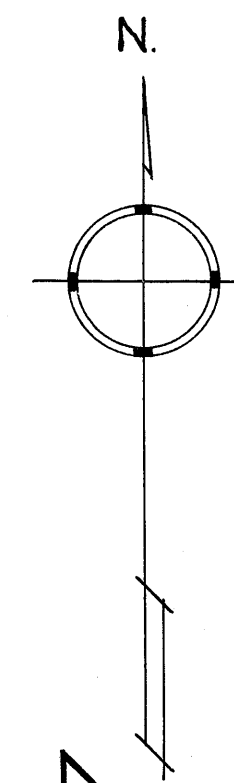


AUDITOR'S SUBDIVISION NUMBER 12
