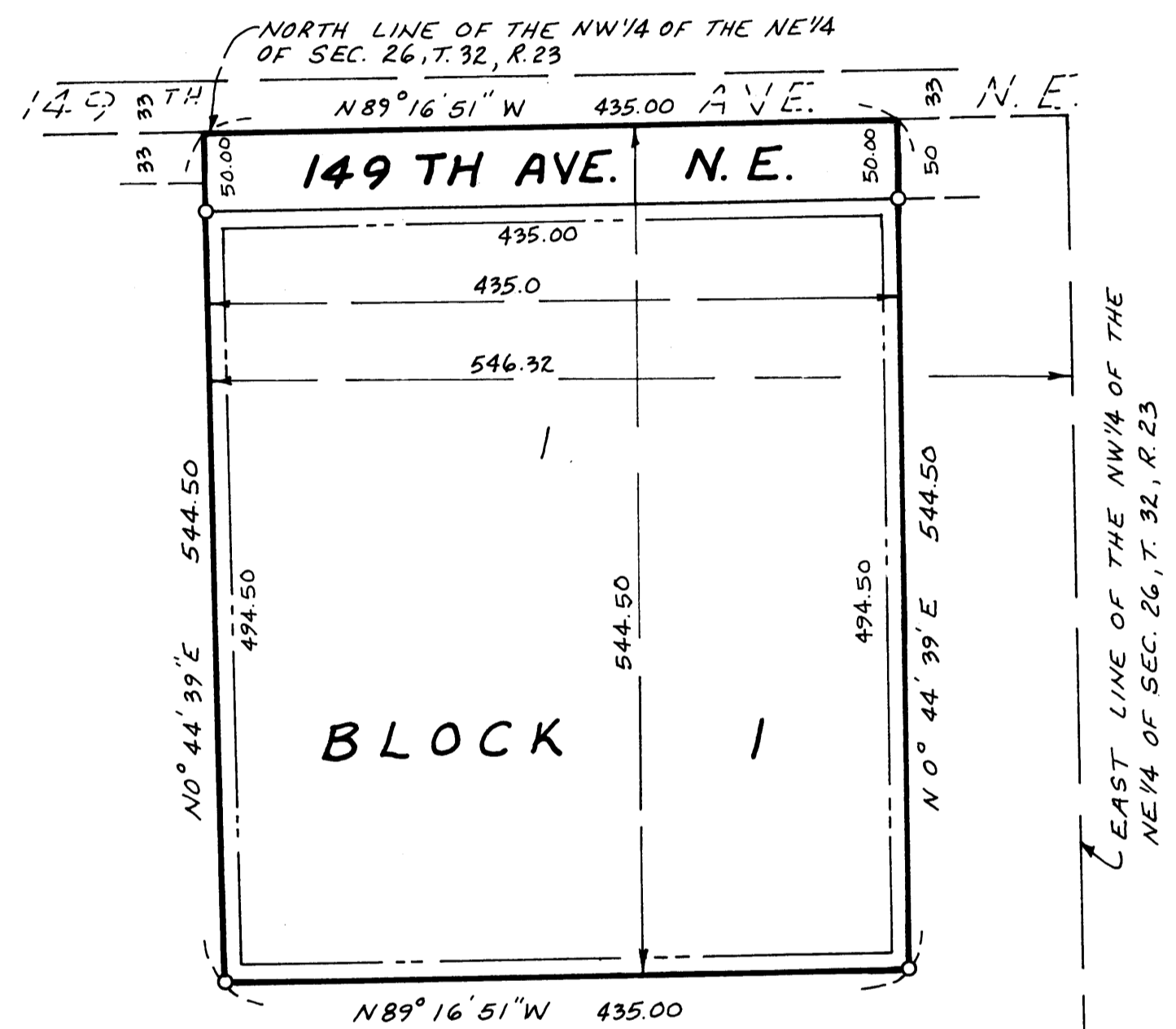


# BRENK ADDITION

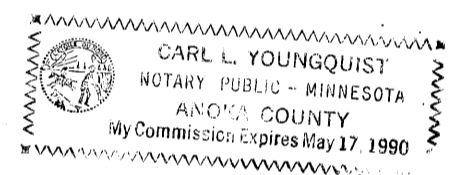

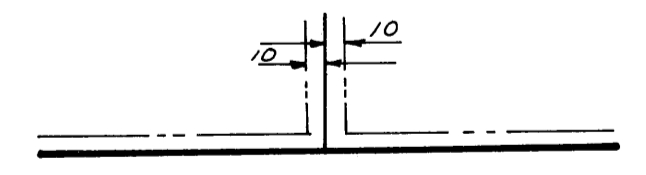

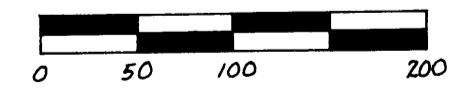
