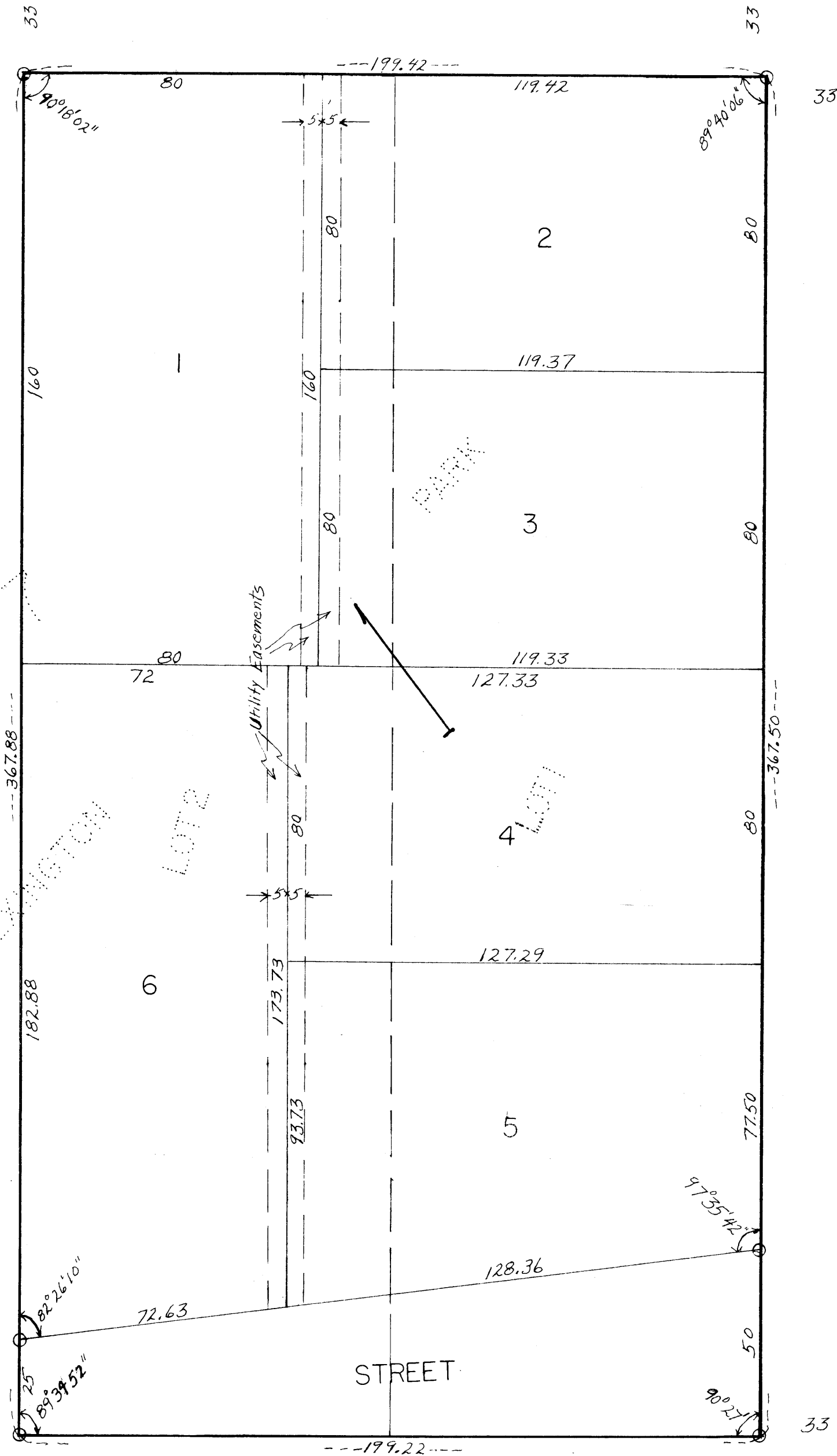


CENTENNIAL SQUARE ADDITION OFFICIAL PLAT
