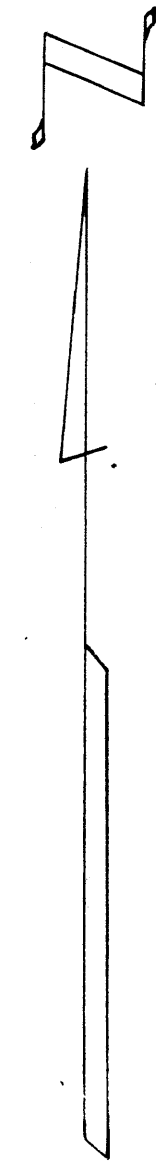
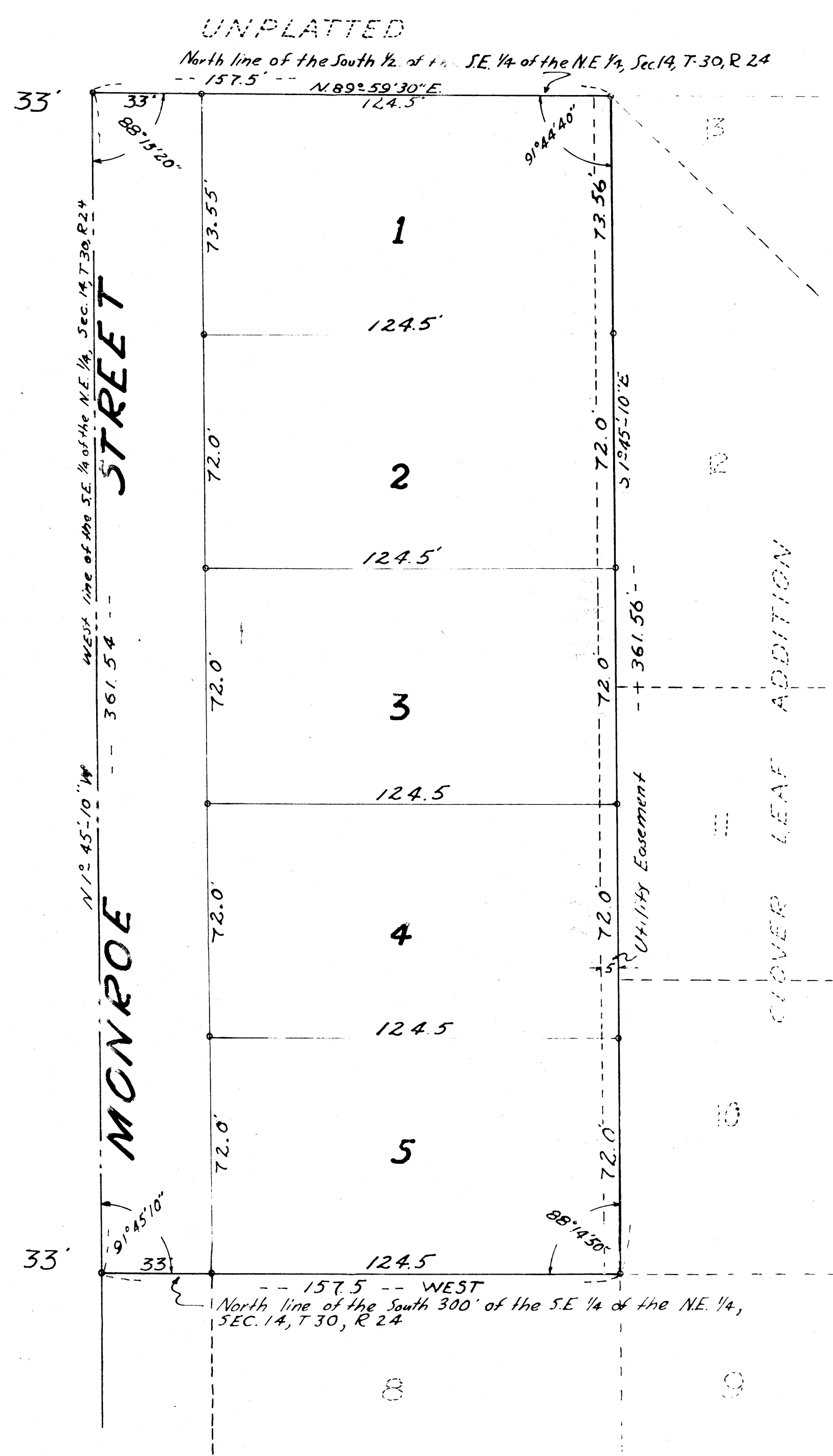


CLOVER LEAF SECOND ADDITION
