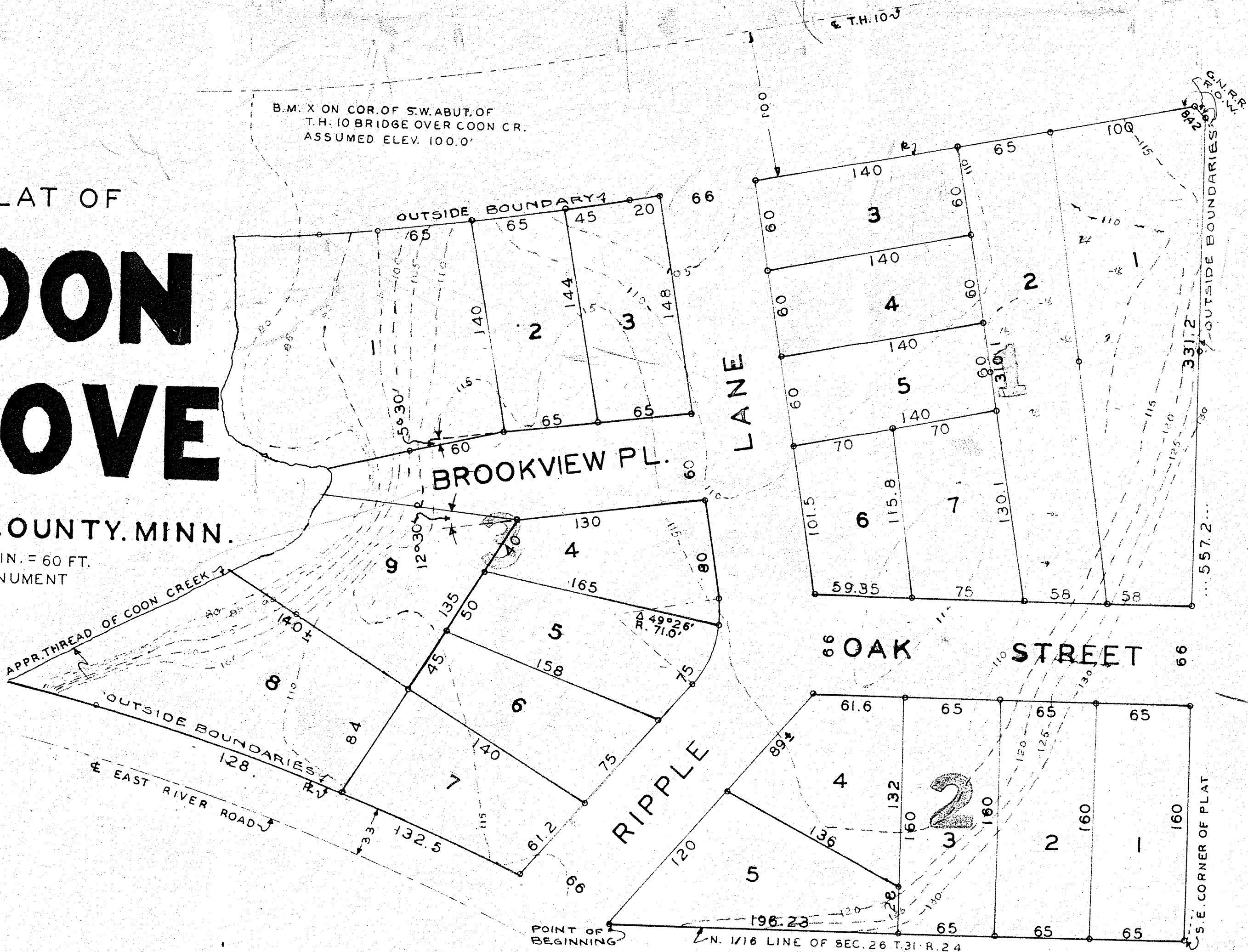


Original

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Chester La Salle and Margaret G. La Salle, his wife, being owners and proprietors of Lots One, Two, Three, Four, Five, Seven, Eight, Nine and Ten (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9 & 10) in Block Three (3) of Coon Creek Park in said County, otherwise described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the North One-Sixteenth Line of Section Twenty Six (26) Township Thirty One (31), Range Twenty Four (24) in said County, which said point is Four Hundred Twenty Two and Three Tenths (422.3) feet distant Easterly along the said One-Sixteenth Line from the Southeast Corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) of the said section; thence North along the said One-Sixteenth Line a distance of Three Hundred Ninety One and Twenty Three Hundredths (391.23) feet to a point thereon; thence North at right angles from the said westerly on and along the said Rail Road Right-of-Way Line a distance of Eight and Forty Two Hundredths (8.42) feet to its point of intersection with the Southerly Right-of-Way Line of Minnesota Trunk Highway Ten (10); thence Westerly on and along the said Trunk Highway Right-of-Way Line to its point of intersection with the thread of Coon Creek; thence North meandering Southerly direction on and along the said thread of Coon Creek to its point of intersection with the Northerly Right-of-Way Line of East River Road; thence Easterly on and along the said Northerly Right-of-Way Line of the said East River Road to the point or place of beginning; HAVE CAUSED the same to be surveyed and re-platted as COON GROVE, and do hereby donate and dedicate to the public, for public use forever as thoroughfares, the tracts shown on the plat above as Ripple Lane, Oak Street, and Brookview Place.
