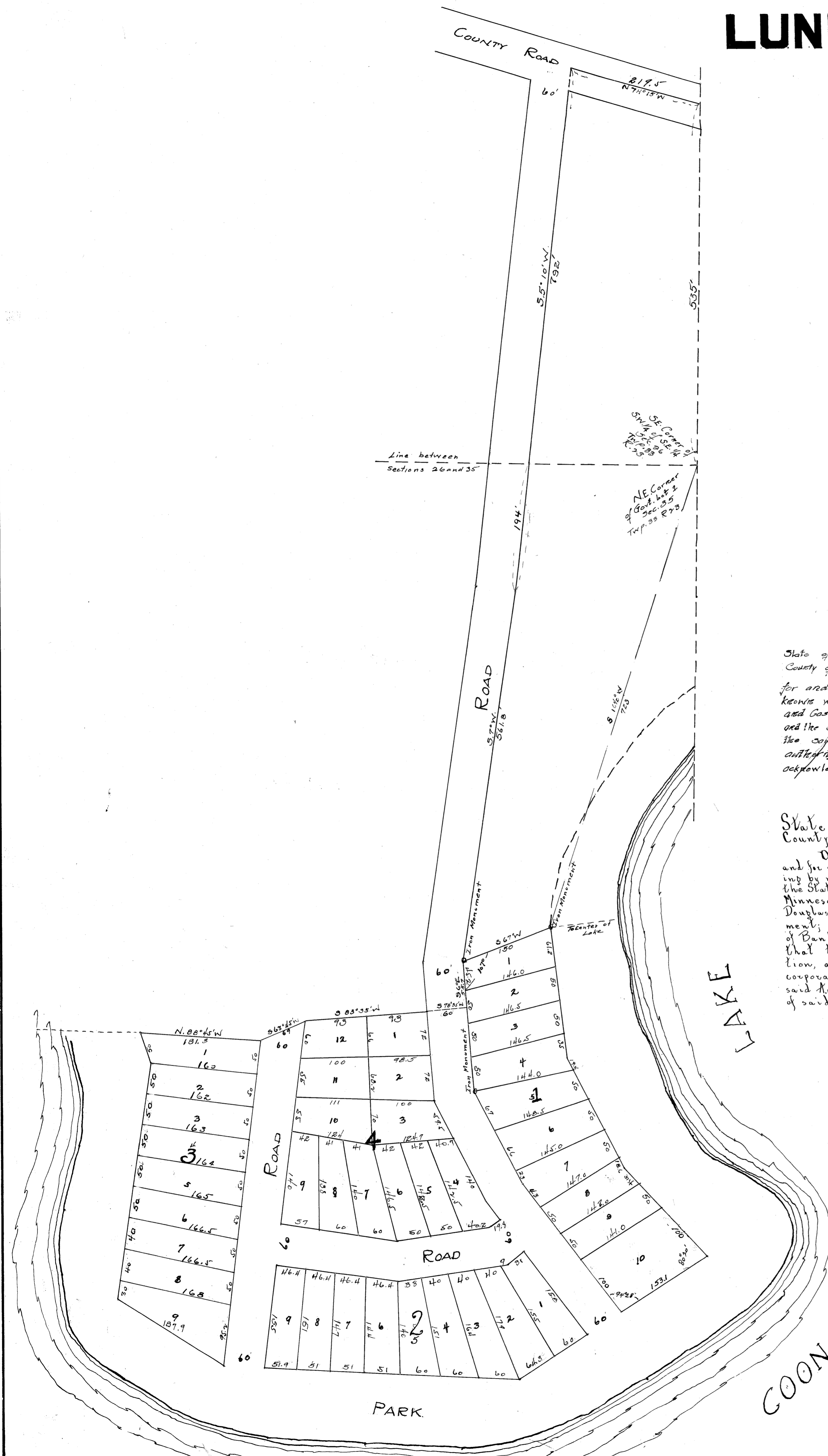


LUNDAHL'S POINT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Gust Lundahl and Hulda Lundahl his wife, owners and the Janesville State Bank, mortgagees of the following described land to wit: all of Govt Lot 1 Sec. 35, Twp. 35 R. 23 lying southerly of the following described line; commencing at a point, said point being 51 1/2' W. distant 705 feet from the North East corner of said Govt Lot 1, and on shore of Coon Lake, thence S 67° W. 150 feet, thence S. 6° E. 55 1/2' feet, thence S. 45° 35' W. 60 feet, thence S. 85° 35' W. 106 feet, thence S. 65° 45' W. 60 feet, thence N. 88° 45' W. 101 1/2' feet to shore of Coon Lake and end of said line; also a strip of land 60 feet wide lying westerly of the following described line; commencing at the South East corner of the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of Section 20, Twp. 35, R. 23, thence N. 88 1/2 feet along East line of said Southwest one-quarter of Southeast one-quarter to center of County Road, thence North 74° 15' W. 81 1/2 feet to point of commencement, thence S. 0° 10' W. 722 feet, thence S. 7° W. 36 1/2 feet, thence S. 6° E. 55 1/2 feet, to end of said line, all with variation of 0° 30' E.; have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as LUNDAHL'S POINT and we do hereby donate and dedicate to the public use forever all roads as shown on the annexed plat.
