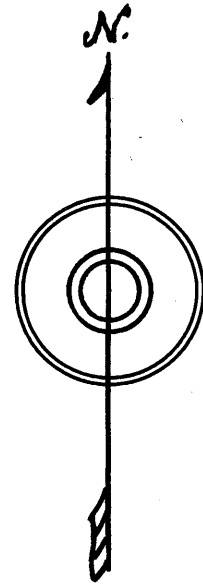


NORTH SHORE. AN AUDITORS PLAT. ANOKA COUNTY MINN.



Scale: 1 inch = 50 feet.

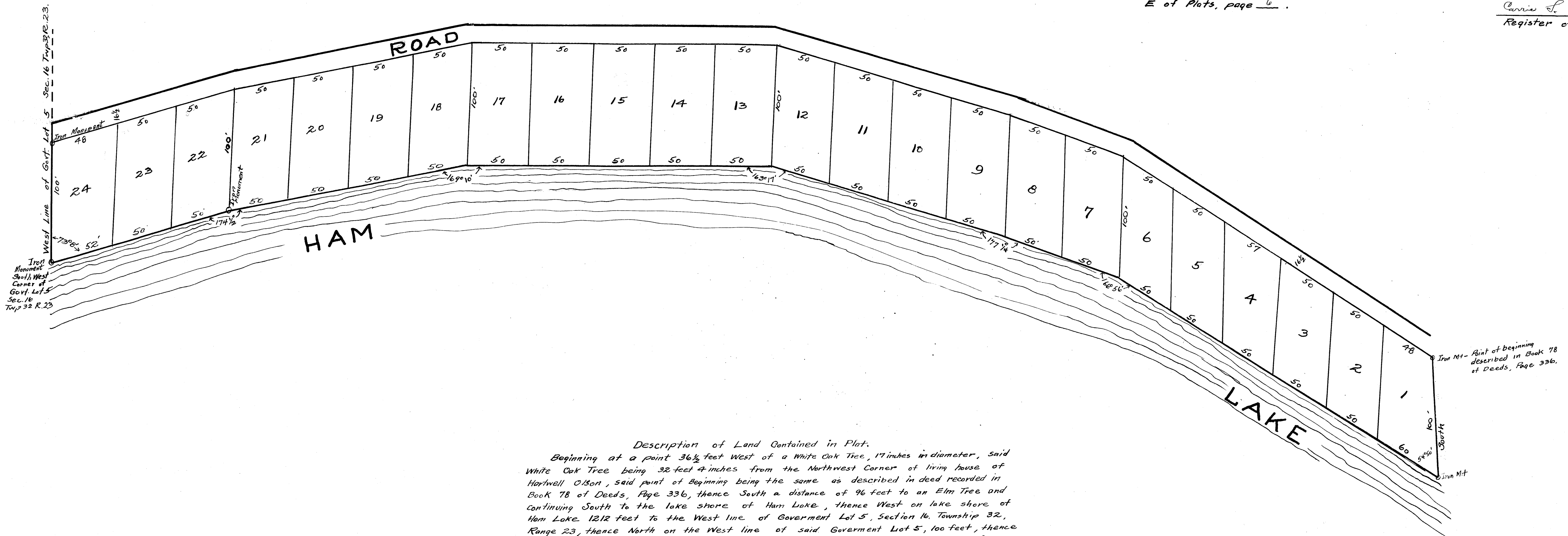

Description of Land Contained in Plat.
Beginning at a point 36 1/2 feet West of a White Oak Tree, 17 inches in diameter, said White Oak Tree being 32 feet 4 inches from the Northwest Corner of living house of Hartwell Olson, said point of Beginning being the same as described in deed recorded in Book 78 of Deeds, Page 336, thence South a distance of 96 feet to an Elm Tree and continuing South to the lake shore of Ham Lake, thence West on lake shore of Ham Lake, 1212 feet to the West line of Government Lot 5, Section 16, Township 32, Range 23, thence North on the West line of said Government Lot 5, 100 feet, thence East and parallel with said lake shore of Ham Lake 1203 feet to the place of beginning, also a right of way to said described land from the road now used by said Hartwell Olson, the described land being part of Government Lot 5, Section 16, Township 32, Range 23.
