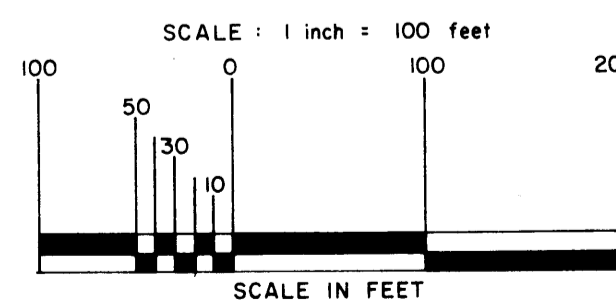
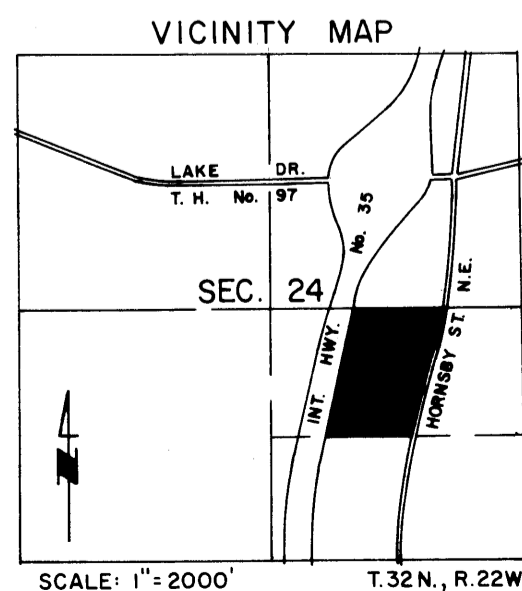
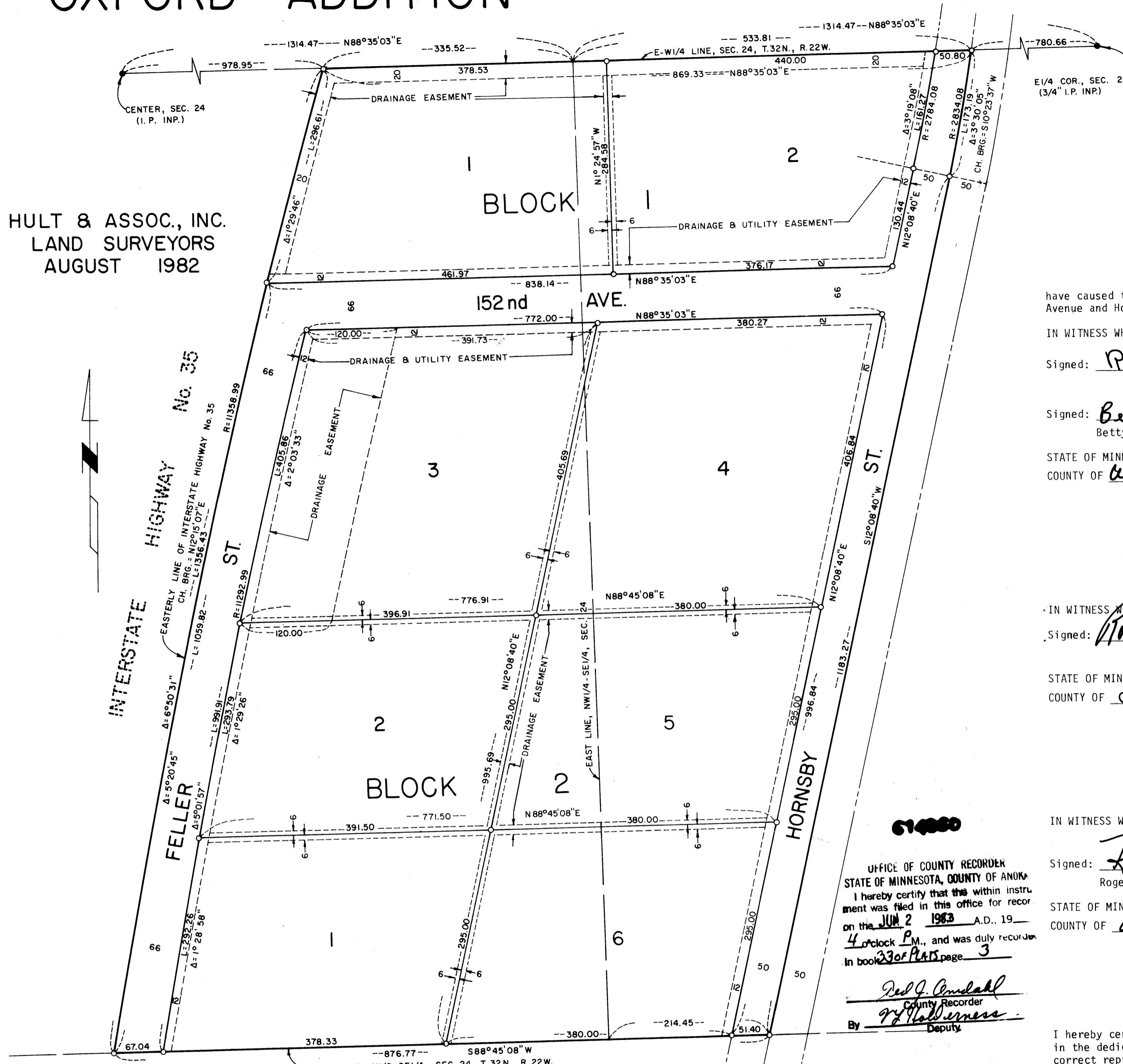

Commencing at the east quarter corner of said Section 24; thence South 88 degrees 35 minutes 03 seconds West, assumed bearing along the north line of said North Half of the Southeast Quarter, 780.66 feet to the center line of Hornsby Street and the point of beginning of the parcel to be described; thence southwesterly, along said center line, a distance of 173.19 feet along a curve not tangent with the last described line, said curve is concave to the west, has a radius of 2834.08 feet, a central angle of 3 degrees 30 minutes 05 seconds, and the chord of said curve bears South 10 degrees 23 minutes 37 seconds West; thence South 12 degrees 08 minutes 40 seconds West, tangent to said curve, 1183.27 feet to the south line of said North Half of the Southeast Quarter; thence South 88 degrees 45 minutes 08 seconds West along said south line, 876.77 feet to the easterly line of Interstate Highway No. 35; thence northeasterly, along said easterly line, a distance of 1356.43 feet, to the north line of said North Half of the Southeast Quarter, along a curve not tangent with the last described line, said curve is concave to the east, has a radius of 11358.99 feet, a central angle of 6 degrees 50 minutes 31 seconds, and the chord of said curve bears North 12 degrees 15 minutes 07 seconds East; thence North 88 degrees 35 minutes 03 seconds East, along said north line and not tangent to said curve, 869.33 feet to the point of beginning.
