The North Half of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 32, Township 31, Range 22, Anoka County, Minnesota.

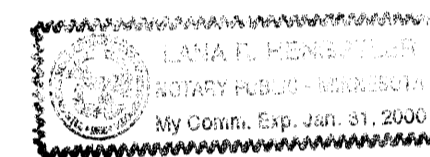

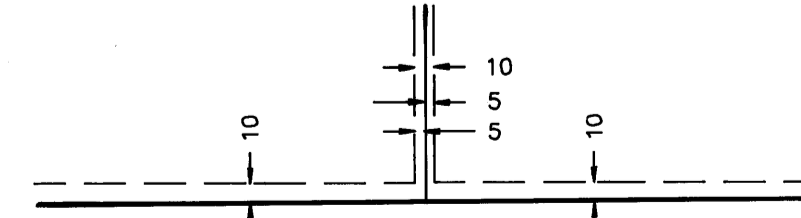

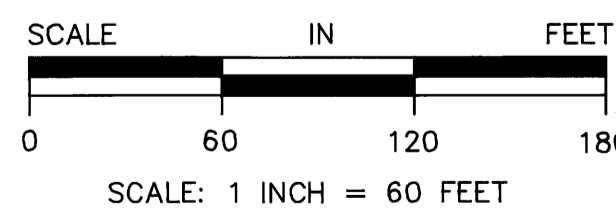

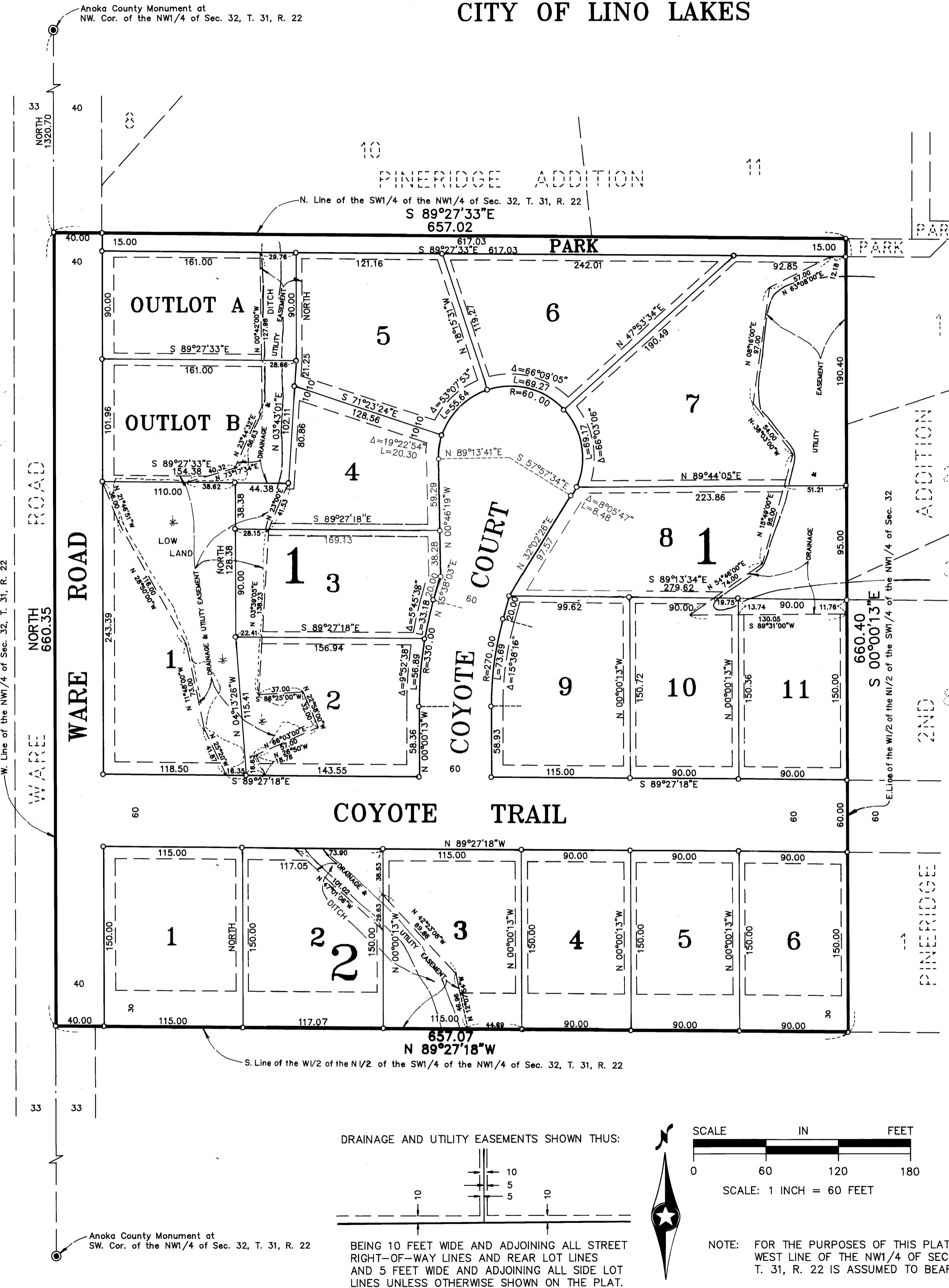
DRAINAGE AND UTILITY EASEMENTS SHOWN THUS:
