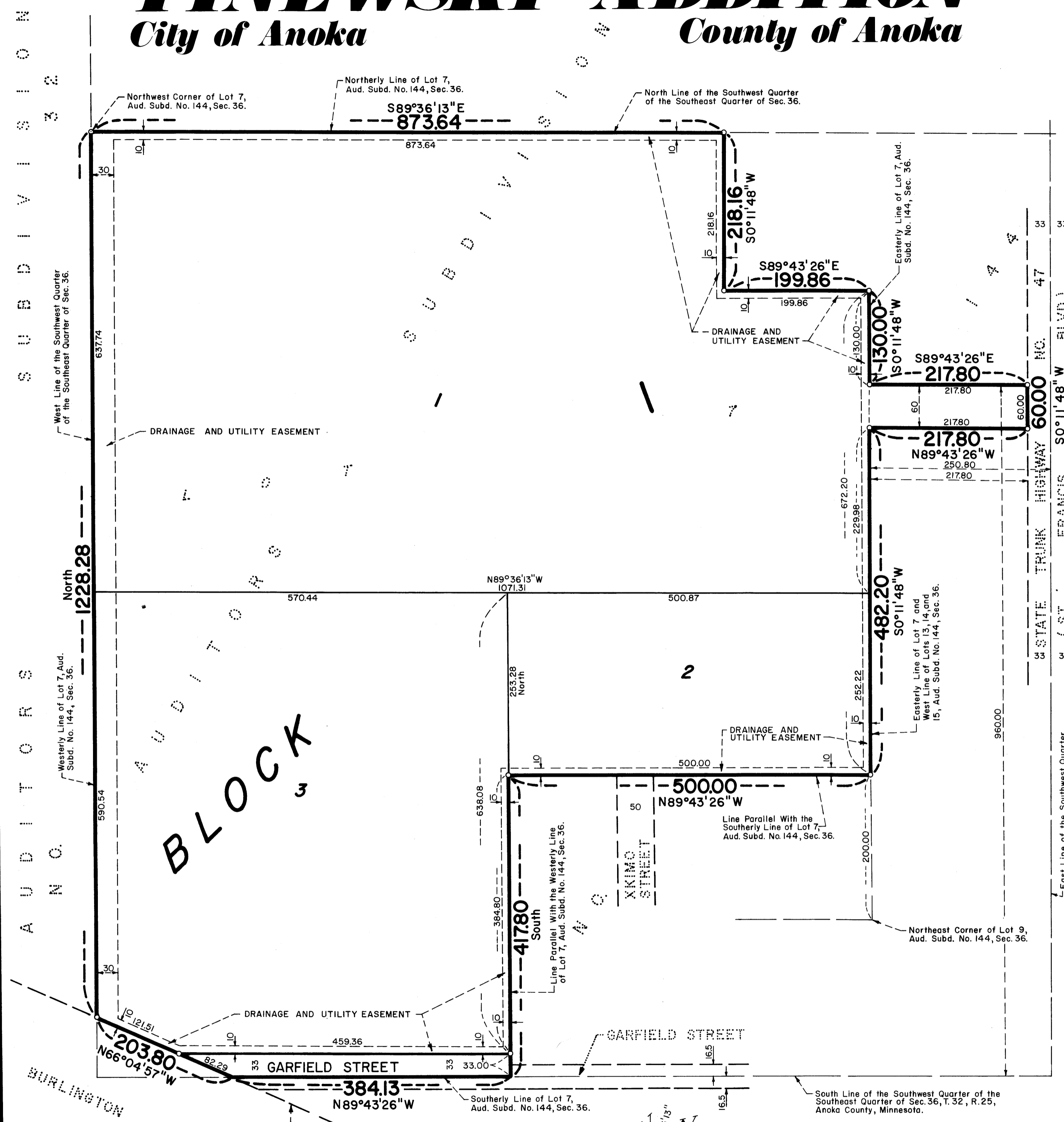


PINEWSKI ADDITION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Phillip A. Pinewski and Marjorie J. Pinewski, his wife, owners and proprietors of the following described property situated in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota, to wit:

That part of Lot 7, Auditor's Subdivision No. 144, Anoka County, Minnesota, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the easterly line of said Lot 7 distant 200.00 feet northerly of the northeast corner of Lot 9 in said subdivision; thence westerly on an assumed bearing of North 89 degrees 43 minutes 26 seconds West, parallel with the southerly line of said Lot 7, a distance of 500.00 feet; thence on a bearing of South, parallel with the westerly line of said Lot 7, a distance of 417.80 feet to the said southerly line of said Lot 7; thence North 89 degrees 43 minutes 26 seconds West, along said southerly line of said Lot 7, a distance of 384.13 feet to the northeasterly line of Burlington Northern Railroad; thence North 66 degrees 04 minutes 57 seconds West, along said northeasterly line of said railroad, a distance of 203.80 feet to the said westerly line of said Lot 7; thence on a bearing of North, along said westerly line of said Lot 7, a distance of 1228.28 feet to the northwest corner of said Lot 7; thence South 89 degrees 36 minutes 13 seconds East, along the northerly line of said Lot 7; a distance of 873.64 feet; thence South 0 degrees 11 minutes 48 seconds West a distance of 218.16 feet; thence South 89 degrees 43 minutes 26 seconds East a distance of 199.86 feet to the said easterly line of said Lot 7; thence South 0 degrees 11 minutes 48 seconds West, along said easterly line of said Lot 7, a distance of 672.20 feet to the point of beginning.

The West 217.8 feet of the East 250.8 feet of the North 60 feet of the South 960 feet of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 36, Township 32, Range 25, now also known as Lot 20, Auditor's Subdivision No. 144, except the North 40 feet thereof, Anoka County, Minnesota.

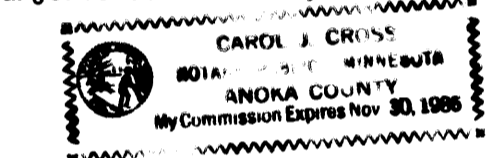

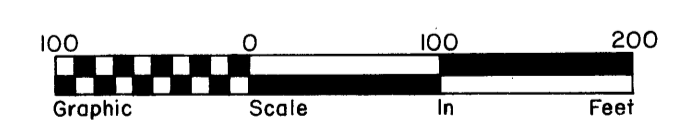

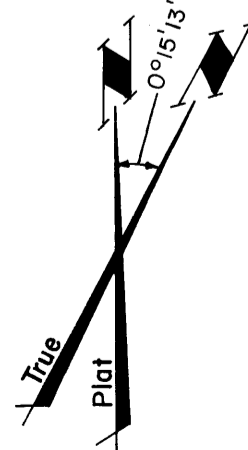
