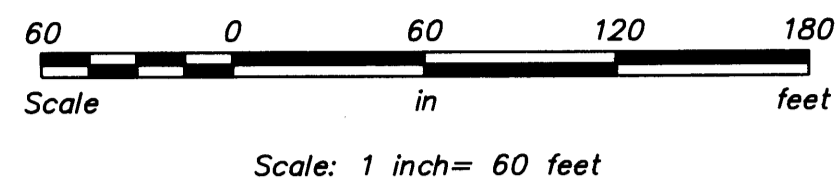
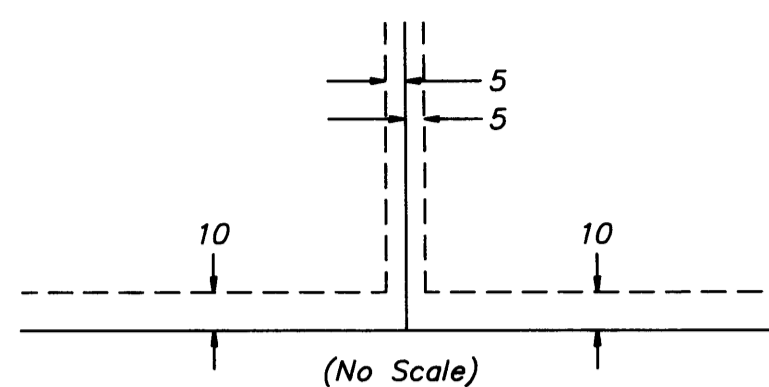


RESHANAU LAKE ESTATES SOUTH 5TH ADDITION

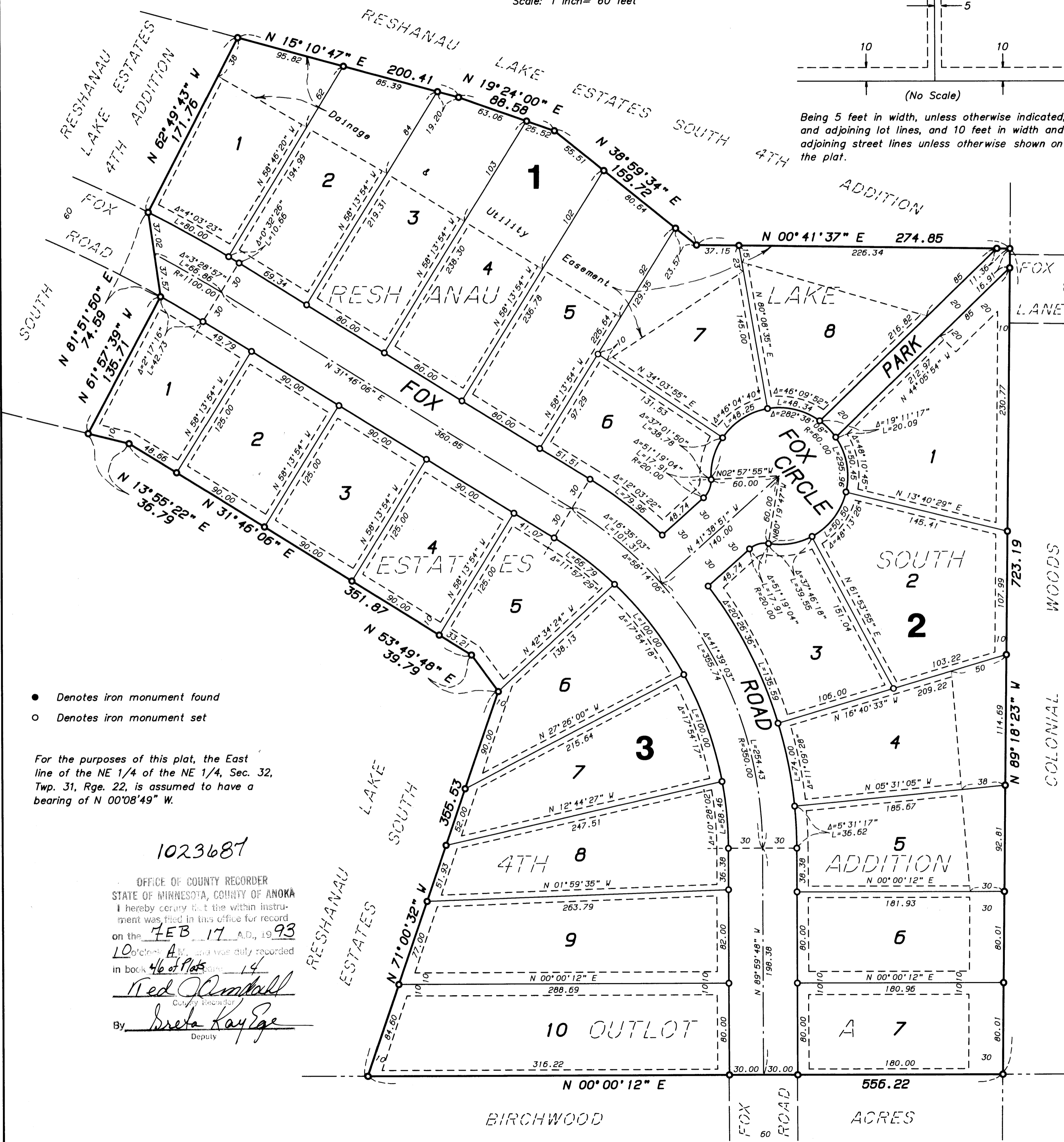
CITY OF LINO LAKES ANOKA COUNTY, MINNESOTA
