

Anoka National Bank, assignees of mortgagee of the following described property to wit:
Commencing 1 rod West and 150.6 feet North of the Southwest corner of the
Southeast one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter of Section 21, Twp. 32, Range 23,
thence North 46° East 937.2 feet, thence North 42° 10' West 374 feet to the shore
of Ham Lake, thence South 41° 24' West 633.4 feet along the shore of Ham Lake to
point 1 rod West of the West line of Lot 1, said Section 21, thence South 45° 7 feet
