Know all men by these presents that we, the Minnesota National Land and Investment Company, (by its President Charles E Jones and its Secretary Calvin E Brown) owners and proprietors, of the following described property situated in the SW 1/4 of Section One (1) Town Thirty one (31) Range twenty five (25) T. of 4th Meridian (City of Anoka) and described as follows, to-wit:—

Commencing at the N.W. corner of Lot Eleven (11) Block Seven (7) N. S. Shaw's Addition to Anoka, thence N. 10° 30' W. to the North line of North 1/2 of S 27 1/2 section one (1) Town Thirty one (31) Range twenty five (25); thence East along said line to the territorial road; thence along Southern side of said road easterly to the N.W. corner of Lot Eleven (11) Block five (5) of Shaw's addition; thence southerly along West line of Block five (5) to a point where the North line of Lot Three (3) Block seven (7) intersects the west line of Lot five (5) Block five (5) in said Shaw's Addition; thence Westerly along N. line of Block seven (7) to point of beginning, containing twenty seven (27) 1/2 acres more or less.
