
TWILIGHT ACRES 2ND ADDITION

That part of Lot 1, Auditor's Subdivision No. 100, Anoka County, Minnesota, lying southerly of the plat of "Twilight Acres"

TOGETHER WITH:

That part of Lot 15, Auditor's Subdivision No. 100, Anoka County, Minnesota, that lies northerly of the centerline of the cartway, as now located and traveled, and that lies westerly of a line described as beginning at the southwesterly corner of Lot 4, Auditor's Subdivision No. 100; thence South 02 degrees 39 minutes 00 seconds West, to the centerline of said cartway and there terminating.

That part of said Lot 1 that lies easterly of a line described as beginning at the southwesterly corner of Lot 4, Auditor's Subdivision No. 100; thence South 02 degrees 39 minutes 00 seconds West, to the southerly line of said Lot 1 and there terminating;

That part of said Lot 1 described as beginning at the northeasterly corner of Lot 4, Auditor's Subdivision No. 100 (being the westerly right-of-way line of State Trunk Highway No. 8); thence in a northwesterly direction, along and on the extension of the northeasterly line of said Lot 4, a distance of 560 feet; thence in a northeasterly direction and parallel with said westerly right-of-way line of State Trunk Highway No. 8 a distance of 274 feet to the south-easterly corner of Lot 3, Block 2, in said plat of "Twilight Acres"; thence continuing northeasterly and parallel with said right-of-way line of State Trunk Highway No. 8, and along the easterly line of said Lot 3, Block 2, Twilight Acres, a distance of 150 feet; thence southeasterly along the southerly line of said Block 2, Twilight Acres, a distance of 560 feet to said westerly right-of-way line of State Trunk Highway No. 8; thence southwesterly, along said westerly right-of-way line, 424 feet to the point of beginning.
