




VINELAND

Know all men by these presents that we: Willis Baker and Hannah M. Baker his wife owners and proprietors and James F. Smith and Ella E. Smith his wife, Mortgagors of the following described property situate in the County of Anoka and State of Minnesota and described as follows to wit: Government Lot Number One (1) in Section fourteen (14) and the South West quarter (S.W. 1/4) of the South East quarter (S.E. 1/4) of Section fourteen (14) all in Town thirty (30) N. Range twenty four (24) W. excepting and deducting therefrom the following to wit: commencing at the North East (NE) corner of Government Lot One (1), Section fourteen (14) Town thirty (30) N. Range twenty four (24) W. thence West along the North line of said Lot One (1) six hundred and sixty five (665) feet, thence South parallel with the East line of said Lot One (1) one thousand (1000) feet, thence at right angles East one hundred and fifty (150) feet to the shore of Moore Lake, thence Easterly along the shore of said lake to the East line of said Lot One (1) thence North along the East line of said Lot One (1) seven hundred and ninety three (793) feet to the place of beginning, have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as "Land Addition to Fridley Park" and we hereby donate and dedicate to the public and for the public use forever all streets avenues and alleys as shown on annexed plat.
