
## WEST MAIN ADDITION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Intercapitalizing, Inc., a Minnesota Corporation, owner and proprietor, and Crosstown State Bank of Cedar, Inc. a Minnesota Corporation, mortgagee, and Equinox Investment Corporation, a Minnesota Corporation, mortgagee of the following described property situated in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota, to wit:

Lots 8, 9 and 10, Block 8, Spark's Addition to the City of Anoka, according to the map or plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder in and for Anoka County, Minnesota, including any portion of vacated Reed Avenue adjacent thereto.

Lots 1, 2 and 3 and vacated Reed Avenue, all in Block 9, Spark's Addition to the City of Anoka, according to the map or plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder in and for Anoka County, Minnesota; Except that part thereof described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the centerline of said Reed Avenue with the south line of State Highway Number 10, as the same is now laid out and constructed, said point being located 3.08 feet north of the East and West Quarter line of Section 1, Township 31, Range 25, Anoka County, Minnesota, as measured along the centerline of said Reed Avenue; thence proceeding South along the centerline of said Reed Avenue for a distance of 145 feet; thence deflect to the left 67 degrees 45 minutes 00 seconds, so as to leave an included angle of 112 degrees 15 minutes 00 seconds, and proceeding thence southeasterly a distance of 90 feet; thence in a direct line to an iron pipe set by Cartwright and Olson on the southerly line of State Highway Number 10 distant 160 feet from the point of commencement; thence continuing on the last described course to the southerly line of State Highway Number 10 as per District Court File 25981; and proceeding thence northwesterly and on the southerly line of said State Highway Number 10 for a distance of 160 feet to the point of commencement.

That part of the vacated street, formerly known as Butterfield Street, according to the plat of Spark's Addition to the City of Anoka, lying easterly of the centerline of Reed Avenue, and that part of Lots 5, 6 and 7, all in Block 8, said Spark's Addition to the City of Anoka, that lies westerly of the following described line: Commencing at a point on the westerly line of Main Street, said point being 25 feet northwesterly along said westerly line from a point formed by the intersection of said westerly line and the centerline of said vacated Butterfield Street; thence proceeding southwesterly to a point on the south line of said Lot 7, said point being 24.5 feet easterly of the southwest corner of said Lot 7, except that part thereof described as follows:

All that part of Lot 7, Block 8, Spark's Addition to the City of Anoka according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder in and for Anoka County, Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the southwesterly line of Main Street distance 25 feet northwesterly of its intersection with the centerline of vacated Butterfield Street; thence southwesterly along a line, the prolongation of which would intersect the south line of said Lot 7 at a point distant 24.5 feet easterly of the southwest corner of said Lot 7, to its intersection with the east line of said Lot 7, said point being the actual point of beginning of land to be described; thence southwesterly to a point on the south line of said Lot 7 distant 24.5 feet easterly to the northwest corner of said Lot 7; thence northeasterly to the point of beginning of land to be described; thence southwest corner of said Lot 7; thence northeasterly to the point of beginning the actual point of the southwest corner of said Lot 7; thence northeasterly to the point of beginning the actual point of the southwest corner of said Lot 7; thence northeasterly to the point of the southwest corner of said Lot 7; thence northeasterly to the point of the southwest corner of said
