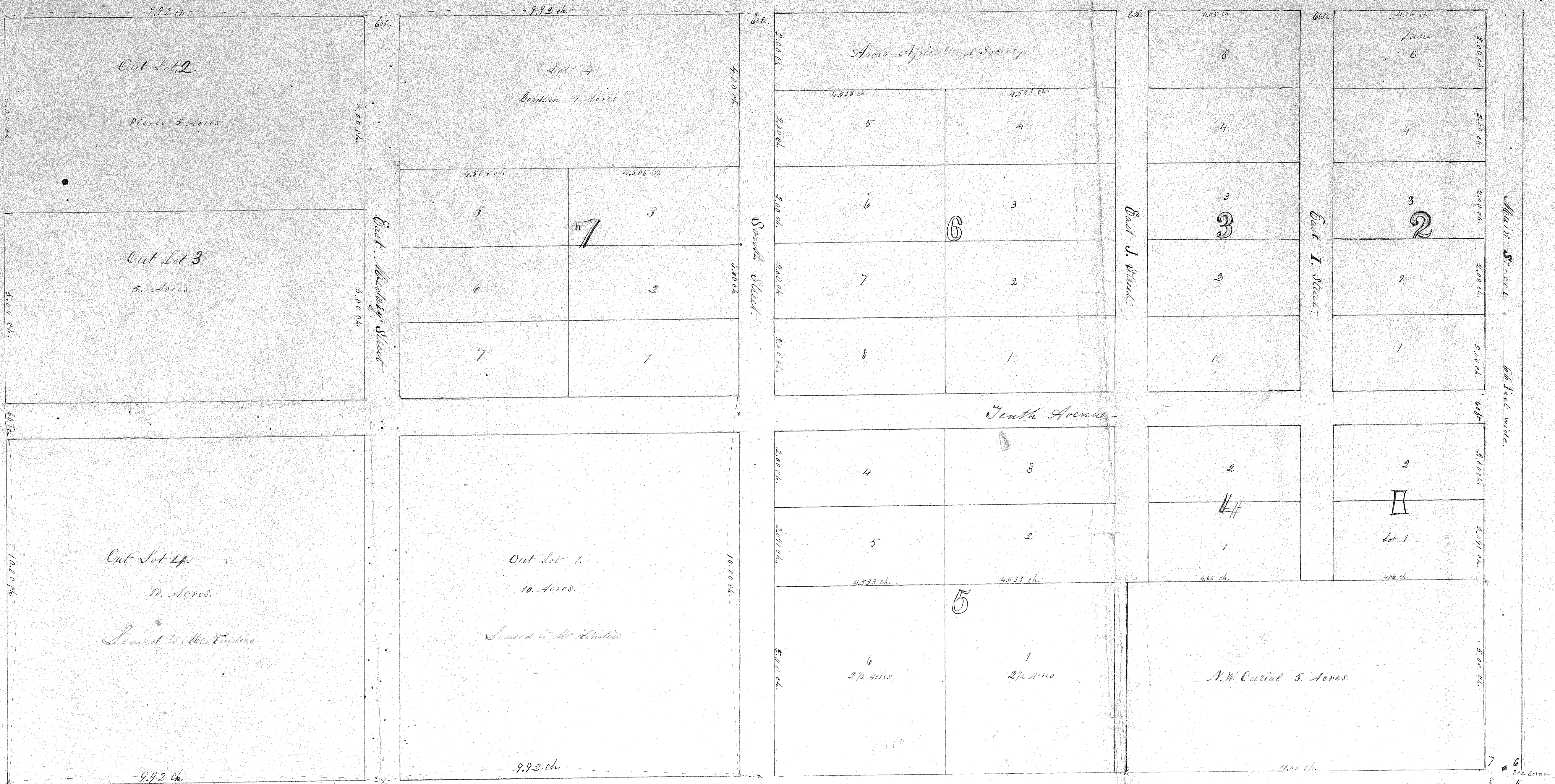


Daughter's Disjoined Addition.
