Cressy owner and proprietor of a certain tract of land situated in the south west quarter of Section One & Township thirty one, Range Twenty five (25) commencing at the N.W. corner of lot No. 13, Block 8 of W.D. have addition to the town, namely of Anoka since January on Clinton Avenue extended 100 feet, thence southerly 40 feet rods to Lafayette Avenue, thence easterly on Lafayette Avenue 100 feet to the W corner of said lot 13, thence northerly 23 1/2 rods to boundary first mentioned. That I have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as Cressy's Addition to Anoka and hereby dedicate all streets and alleys as shown thereon to the public use forever.


