CORNER HISTORY:

February 7, **1963** - Found steel fence post set by N.C. Hoium. Replaced with 1" X 9' iron pipe up 3.5'± above water with 6" red and white painted bands.

July 18, 1972 - Found 1" iron pipe and updated ties.

November 9, 1973 - Unable to access monument due to water.

January 19, 1978 - Found 1" iron pipe missing. Creek had been dredged.

June 14, 1978 - Reset position of corner with1-1/2" iron pipe up 1.5'± in center of Coon Creek using area resurvey and established ties to monument.

June 14, 1979 - Found 1-1/2" iron pipe and updated ties.

October 24, 1988 - Found 1-1/2" iron pipe missing. Unable to reset monument in corner position because of ditch. Position determined mathematically only.
