

May 17, 1977 - Found Cast Iron Monument and updated ties.

July 28, 1980 - Found Cast Iron Monument and updated ties.

July 21, 1986 - Found Cast Iron Monument and updated ties.

October 23, 1991 - Found Cast Iron Monument with a sign and post on the north side. Updated ties.

July 15, 1996 - Found Cast Iron Monument and updated ties.

February 25, 1998 - Found Cast Iron Monument with a sign and post on the north side and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods. Updated ties.

August 31, 2010 - Found Cast Iron Monument flush with the surface and updated ties.

January 23, 2017 - Found Cast Iron Monument flush with the surface and updated ties.
