


was placed consisting of a cast iron monument

HISTORY OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

County of Anoka

State of Minnesota

<u>Witness</u> Corner of Sec. <u>6</u> Township <u>32</u> Range <u>24</u>

(on north line of section east of Rum River)

CORNER HISTORY:

May 4, 1966 - Set cast iron monument down $0.2'\pm$ on north line of Section 6. Established face ties for approximate location purposes only. Landowner would not allow the use of nails and washers.

August 3, 1971 - Landowner would not allow us to access the corner.

5/31/84, 6/16/92 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

December 15, 2000 - Found cast iron monument and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods. Updated ties.

October 29, 2010 - Found cast iron monument down 1'± with a "T" fence post on north side of monument.

May 6, 2011 - Set sign and post on west side of cast iron monument.

8/2/16, 9/24/20, 6/9/23 - Found cast iron monument down 1'± with a "T" fence post on north side of monument and a sign and post on west side of cast iron monument. Updated ties.

July 21, 2023; Removed found cast iron monument. Replaced with 2" square steel telspar with aluminum cap and punch mark, set up 0.2'±. Previous postion N=196077.1771 E=471575.5754

Corner moved 10' Easterly along section line to a new position due to river bank erosion using ACS RTK GPS method. New ties established to shifted corner position. Sign and post added to West side.
