## **CORNER HISTORY:**

May 15, 1959 - Found granite monument that Minnesota Highway Department had found. MNDOT painted a yellow circle on top and was found to have a cross on top. Mrs. Russell, who has a tract of land in the SE corner of Section 12, Ramsey County, reported that former County Commissioner Stack said that this rock had been used since 1870. Established ties to monument.

May 17, 1968 - Found granite rock and established additional ties prior to road construction. Granite rock is to be removed.

July 30, 1968 - Replaced granite rock with a cast iron monument set down 0.6'± after road construction and updated ties.

June 29, 1972 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 1, 1976 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 4, 1979 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 21, 1982 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

May 29, 1985 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 28, 1988 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 15, 1993 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

**September 7**, 1999 - Found cast iron monument and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods. Updated ties.

November 3, 2010 - Found cast iron monument flush with the surface and updated ties.
