CORNER HISTORY:

Date unknown - N.C. Hoium set iron pipe on a straight line and equal distance between the northwest corner and the southwest corner of Section 16 and established ties to monument.

August 22, 1964 - Found 1/2" iron pipe down 0.1' using N.C. Hoium ties. Established ties to monument.

June 3, 1965 - Replaced 1/2" iron pipe with a cast iron monument. Updated ties.

July 9, 1968 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 23, 1972 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties. Set P.K. nails north and east of monument.

Date unknown - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 1, 1976 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

October 2, 1980 - Set cast iron monument after road construction and tied into section corners to north and south. Updated ties.

June 23, 1982 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

May 29, 1985 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 9, 1988 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 15, 1993 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 7, 1996 - Replaced cast iron monument with a new cast iron monument. Updated ties.

October 2, 2000 - Found cast iron monument and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods. Updated ties.

July 18, 2001 - Set construction ties and removed cast iron monument prior to road construction. Date reset after construction is unknown.

December 10, 2010 - Found cast iron monument flush with the surface and updated ties.
