July 15, 1968 - Found 1/2" iron pipe and updated ties.

September 9, 1968 - Replaced 1/2 " iron pipe with a cast iron monument set flush with the surface. Set P.K. nails 2.00' north and east of monument and updated ties.

July 6, 1972 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 21, 1973 - Added spacer/s and replaced top of cast iron monument. Monument is flush with surface. Updated ties.

June 9, 1976 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 7, 1979 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 30, 1982 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 4, 1985 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 2, 1988 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 19, 1993 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

October 2, 2000 - Found cast iron monument and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods. Updated ties.

October 20, 2010 - Found cast iron monument flush with the surface and updated ties.

May 24, 2012 - Loosened top of cast iron monument prior to overlaying road surface.

June 2012 - Added spacer/s and replaced top of cast iron monument. Monument is flush with surface. Updated ties.
